
Amanite de Jackson Amanita jacksonii





Traits: Cap up to 5-15 cm diam., striated, orange to bright red towards apex; free yellowish gills; stipe up to 20 cm, yellow, covered with red fibrils, yellow veil, white sac-like volva; white spores

When: rare, isolated July → Sept.

Where: with young oaks and beechs

Risks: confusion with Fly-agaric and

other dubious Amanitas
