Yellow Bolete (Slippery Jack) Suillus luteus

Traits: Cap brown, darkening and flattening with time, up to 14 cm in diam., covered with white visquous cuticule; yellow pores getting darker; stipe up to 10 cm high with partial white veil; white flesh; brown spores

When: Aug. → Oct., sometimes June

Where: abundant under young pines throughout N. A.

Risks: laxative visquous cuticule, peel or dry
