Brown Beech (buna shimeji) and Elm Oyster

Hypsizygus tessulatus & H. ulmarius



Traits: caps up to 12 / 20 cm in diam, brown or white (bunapi shimeji); gills cream-pinkish; stem up to 3 cm, bent, withish; fleshy, mild odor; white spores **When**: abundant July →Nov.

Where: on trunk of alive or dead deciduous, maple,

poplar, birch, beech, elm, willow

Note: confusion one with the other, with oyster (shorter stem) and fried chicken mushroom (on the ground);

extensively cultivated
