




Note 1: If you plan to use your cabinets against a side wall, you will need to remove the side crown moulding to achieve flush installation.

Step 1 Notes: Remove the bolts and washers from the inside of the cabinet using the Allen wrench which is included inside the specially marked red color hardware bag. (this hardware bag is included with the cabinet).

Note 2: You may wish to keep the side crown moulding piece and hardwares for future use.

Noted 3: If you plan to use your cabinets (825-H30 + 825-HB30) against a side wall,

you will also need to remove the side base moulding of 825-HB30 to achieve flush installation.


Step 2 Notes: To access the bolts which hold the base moulding in place, you will need to turn the cabinet upside down.Please use a blanket or other soft material to prevent scratching.

Step 3 Notes: Remove the bolts and washers from the inside of the cabinet using the Allen wrench which is included inside the specially marked red color hardware bag. (this hardware bag is included with the cabinet)

Note 4: You may wish to keep the side base moulding piece and hardwares for future use

The mending plates(C) have been attached on the back of the Double Tower Hutch and screws (B) are included inside the specially marked red color hardware bag. (This hardware bag is included with the cabinet)


Step 5 Notes: Once you have moved these cabinets into their final position, Use the Wall Anchor Kit (D) to attach the top of the 825-H30 Double Hutch Tower to the wall.

The Wall Anchor Hardware Kits (D) are included inside the specially marked white color hardware bags. (Two hardware bags are included with the cabinet)

Note 5: Once you have successfully secured these cabinets to the wall, you place the glass shelf into position. The glass shelf is placed in the upper portion of Double Tower Hutch (behind the glass doors).

Step 6 Notes: Insert the Shelf Pins (C) into the pre-drilled holes on each side of the interior of the cabinet.

There are three height levels so you can choose your ideal placement for the glass shelf.

The Shelf Pins are included inside the specially marked red color hardware bag.







Step 3: Remove the bolts and washers from the inside of the cabinet using the Allen wrench which is included inside the specially marked red color hardware bag. (this hardware bag is included with the cabinet) Step 3a: Once you have removed the side molding, you

may place the cabinet against a side wall to achieve a "built-in" appearance for your cabinet.





Properly align and secure the countertop to the cabinet with high quality adhesive.




