
USEFUL ADVICE TO GET BEST RESULTS



Please take just 2 minutes to check over this information so everyone can help the children maximise the whole 'my art' experience and end up with the best results!

Please encourage the children to use **BOLD BRIGHT** colours using paints or felt tip pens

Pencils. Chalk. Pastels and Charcoal will look flat and pale when compared with the above methods. They just don't have the same impact when scanned!

Also using shiny material such as foil or mirrored paper can give poor results when scanned. Gold can appear a dirty green and silver appear black!

or maybe use collages with varying textures using **BRIGHT COLOURED PAPERS**

Please make sure the collage paper is stuck on with plenty of glue and lies as flat as possible to help it go through our scanners.

Please DO NOT use Glitter in any form It can damage our machinery and gets everywhere including other childrens artwork!

We reserve the right to not scan artwork that uses glitter as this can damage our machines

Keep important detail away from the edge of the paper!

BE EDGE AWARE

Make sure you take any backgrounds right to the edges of the template However...please be 'Edge Aware' with the critical elements of your design.

SAFE ZONE

(approx. 5mm from edge of template)

Keep critical elements (hats, feet, hands, noses etc. and any text) within this zone. This is the only way to avoid these elements being trimmed off on the final product.

Avoid drawing guide lines on the templates as these will appear on the finished product.
