
The Army of Bohemia's March to Dresden

The official Austrian history for 1813 (Glaise von Horstenau, *Feldzug von Dresden*, 1913) gives a very detailed account of Allied movements from 21-24 August. Trawling through the text (approx. pages 80–117) yields the following general results—note that this does <u>not</u> track every division or deviation as much as one might wish, but it gives a good sense of the principal routes of advance the Allies employed to march out of Bohemia into Saxony.

Great confusion resulted from the revised orders issued on the morning of 23 August when subordinate commanders already had instructions for that day. What happened, of course, was that some units received the revised orders and were able to comply, others received them late and could only comply in a belated fashion with great exertion, others never seem to have received the new orders at all or not till the next day. This accounts for the semi-rest day Schwarzenberg authorized for 24 August and some of the seemingly odd entries below
