


M-1000 56" Round Table Assembly Instructions

NOTE: Check contents and read directions carefully before assembly. Report missing or damaged items to *Moon Valley customer service at 313-766-4950*. Cracking or checking of logs is a *natural* part of the drying process of cedar and *does not affect the structural integrity of the wood*.

56" Round Table Components


- (1) Pre-assembled Tabletop (A)
- (4) Pre-assembled Seats (**B**)
- (4) Long underlays (C)
- (4) Legs (**H**)
- (4) Small underlay leg braces (with four holes) (E)
- (8) 11" Braces (**F**)
- (8) 20" Seat Braces (**J**)
- (4) T- Nuts (**Bb**)
- (4) Levelers (Aa)
- (20) 4" Lag Bolts (**G**)
- (52) 2 ½" Lag Bolts (I)
- (4) 7 ³/₄" x 3/8" Machine Bolts (**D**)
- (8) 3/8" Washers (**U**)
- (4) 3/8" Nuts (X)
- (72) 1/4" Washers (**W**)

<u>Tools Needed:</u> Rubber Mallet, Sockets, Wrench, Drill, Screwdriver, Tape Measure, Pencil




Section 1: Table Frame Assembly


Step 1: Lay four long underlays (**C**) on ground, table, or bench. As show in the picture, lay two of the four underlays (**C**) with countersunk holes facing up and remaining two with notched side facing up.




Step 2: Place the two underlays (**C**) with the countersunk holes facing up into the two underlays (**C**) with the notches facing up.



Step 3: Position one leg (**H**), with the "x" facing up, and angle facing out, between the parallel underlays (**C**). Line up pre-drilled holes on long underlays with pre-drilled leg hole. Use hammer to insert 7 3/4" machine bolt (**D**), with 3/8" washer, through countersunk holes in underlay (**C**) the pre-drilled hole of the leg (**H**). Secure with another 3/8" and nut. Repeat for all legs (**H**).




Step 4: Use 2 ½" lag bolts (**I**) in the countersunk holes where the underlays (**C**) intersect to secure frame. Use ¼" washers (**W**) when inserting lag bolts. At this point the legs will still be able to move until secured in a later step.




Step 5: Attach small angle braces (**E**) to corners of frame using 2 ½" lag bolts (I) and washers (W) in all four of the countersunk holes. Repeat for remaining three braces.


Section 2: Assembly Table Frame to Tabletop




Step 6: Lay pre-assembled tabletop (**A**) upside down on a padded surface. Position table frame and leg assembly over table top as shown, align and secure leg (**H**) to wing brace using 4" lag bolt (**G**) and ½" washer (**W**). Repeat this process to secure remaining legs to tabletop.





Step 7: Align and attach 11" braces (**F**) from legs (**H**) to underside of table, using 2 ½" lag bolts (**I**) and ½" washers (**W**).





Step 8: Attach pre-assembled seat (**B**) to frame as shown (**C**). Align to back edge of seat (**B**) with ends of braces (**C**), and measure to center seat as much as possible. Use 4" lag bolts (**G**) through the pre-drilled holes in the braces (**C**) to secure. Use a ½" washer (**W**) when fastening the lag bolt. Note: Use a level to get the best alignment for the seat. Seats may still appear crooked at this point. This should be corrected in the next step.





Step 9: Use 20" brace (**J**) on each side of table legs (**H**) to support seat, attach from leg to seat underlay (**B**) (as shown). Use 2 ½" lag bolts (**I**) and washers (**W**) through pre-drilled holes in all 8 braces (**J**). Place t-nut (**Bb**) with prongs facing down and tap into pre-drilled hole in end of table leg. Screw leveler (**Aa**) into t-nut (**Bb**). Place table upright and adjust metal leveling screws (**Aa**) as needed.
