Name of Product: Super Jumper Trampolines

Hazard: The welds on the metal legs can fail, posing fall and injury hazards.

Remedy: Repair

Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled trampolines and contact Super Jumper for a free repair kit.

Units: About 23,000

Description:

This recall involves Super Jumper 14-foot trampolines, and 14-foot and 16-foot combo trampolines with enclosures. Super Jumper's Logo is printed on center of the trampoline's mat. The trampolines have a black trampoline mat, gold springs and blue pat covering the springs. The 14-foot have four U-shape legs, and 16-foot have Six U-shape legs.

Incidents/Injuries: Super Jump has received 97 reports of the welds on the metal legs breaking, resulting in three scrapes and bruises injuries.
