

Boogie Bikes – Classic Cruiser Basket Install

1. Open your package and cut zip ties holding parts kit off of the basket taking care not to scratch the finish on the basket



2. Check to ensure all the parts needed are included:

3. Remove screws from Axle Struts, Move the Axle Strut out to the last whole and Re-install. Note: If longer struts are needed, order the Basket extension kit.



4. Install Strut loops on the bottom of basket using the smaller hole, and secure with smaller screws and nut (Note: Do not fully tighten until the assembly is complete, then make sure to secure)

5. Install the basket straps over the handle bar (do not fasten yet)



6. Remove Axle nut and install strut. It is best to remove one at a time. Secure axle to 30NM when complete.

7. Check the spacing on basket straps and install. Make sure to clear wires. If the screw will not easily slip under the handle bars the basket strap should be pushed farther down onto the handle bars. The plastic protectors can be used under the straps if needed.



8. Make sure all screws are tight and secured and no wires are pinched. Call Boogie Bikes if you have any questions or safety concerns.
