AIR REFRESH

2-IN-1 AIR PURIFIER AND HUMIDIFIER

Maintenance Instructions

DO NOT leave water to sit in the Water Tank or Humidifier Base when unit is not in use. This may result in mineral deposit and bacteria buildup that can affect humidifier performance.

⚠ **WARNING** ⚠ Always turn off power and unplug from the outlet before cleaning.

⚠ **WARNING** ⚠ Distilled or Filtered Water is Highly Recommended. DO NOT Use Tap Water.

Regular Maintenance

- 1 Empty water tank and wipe the outside of tank with a dry cloth.
- 2 Stand the unit over a sink or bathtub and pull the drainage cap to empty additional water.
- 3 Wipe the bottom humidifier base with a dry cloth.

Weekly Maintenance

- 1 Use 3% hydrogen peroxide to sanitize. Follow manufacturer warnings and safety instructions when using 3% hydrogen peroxide.
- 2 Pour the 3% hydrogen peroxide into water tank until approximately half full, replace cap and shake vigorously.
- 3 Pour approximately 10 oz. (1 ¼ cup) of 3% hydrogen peroxide into humidifier base. Ensure the drainage cap is inserted into machine.
- 4 Let hydrogen peroxide sit in both of the water tank and humidifier base for 20 minutes.
- 5 **To remove hydrogen peroxide from water tank:** twist cap counter-clockwise to open. Empty solution and rinse thoroughly with distilled or filtered water until any residual hydrogen peroxide smell is gone. Wipe outside of tank with a dry cloth.
- 6 **To remove hydrogen peroxide from humidifier base:** stand the unit over a sink or bathtub and pull the drainage cap to empty additional solution. Rinse thoroughly with distilled or filtered water until any residual hydrogen peroxide smell is gone. Wipe base with a dry cloth.
