## FIND YOUR RING SIZE

Take one of your rings that fits well on the finger you plan to wear your new Casato ring on.
Print this size page making sure the "Scale to fit" option is unchecked in the print dialogue box. Use a ruler to check that the ring conversion chart is scaled to $100 \%$. Now place your ring over the circles below to determine which one matches your size. The inside of the ring should exactly match with the circle.

The best way to know your correct bracelet size is to measure your wrist using a soft tape measure. Wrap a soft tape measure around your wrist, just below the wrist bone. Make sure it is not too tight. Close the tape measure as if it were the bracelet itself. The
number that lines up with the start on the tape is the circumference of your wrist. Note down your measurement and compare it to the bracelet size chart below. If you are between two sizes, we suggest you to opt for the larger size. If you do not have a tape measure, you can use a ribbon or a cord, wrap it around your wrist and measure the length using a ruler.
