

1992-2017 Dodge Viper Front Stabilizer Bar Link Heat Shields

Overview:

Radiated brake rotor heat can cause the boots or ball joints on the OEM and aftermarket stabilizer bar links to melt or degrade. The stainless steel heat shields greatly reduce the heat the end link joint and/or boot are exposed to and install in minutes.

Compatibility:

The heat shields are compatible for any 1992-2017 Viper.

Construction:

The brackets are manufactured from 304 stainless steel and cadmium plated for compatibility with the aluminum control arms.

Weight:

A set of 4 shields weigh 0.332 lbs.

Installation Guide:

- 1. Gain Access to the sway bar link nuts.
- 2. Remove the upper and lower nuts, install the shield and orient to avoid contact with any other component of the suspension. Reinstall the nuts.
- 3. Tighten the upper/lower link bolt to 17 lb-ft.
- 4. Bend the shield orientation nut lock into the nut to avoid any rotation. This can be done on the flat or corner of the nut.

Inspection and Maintenance:

Periodically inspect the shield and hardware to ensure nothing is loose or damaged.
