Brunello's little brother – Rosso di Montalcino – is a wine with the same characteristics, made from the same grape Sangiovese Grosso. This wine ages in Slavonian oak and tonneaux (500 liter) for 18 months. A young red wine that combines vivacity and freshness with an excellent structure.
