## HOW TO CHARGE PWR DUALLY BATTERY

- 1. Plug the wall outlet cable into the power converter box. [Figure 1]
- 2. Plug the round pin connector into the battery.
  - a. When the battery is on the bike, the charging port is on the right-hand side of the battery.
  - b. You will need to pop open the rubber cover that protects the charging port to plug in the charging cable. [Figure 2]
  - c. You can charge the battery when it is on or off the bike.
  - d. Once the charging port is open, plug in the charging cable to the battery. [Figure 3]
- 3. Plug the charger into your wall outlet or power source. [Figure 4]
- 4. While the battery is charging the indicator light on the converter box will show a red light. [Figure 5]
- 5. When the battery is fully charged the converter box will show a green light. [Figure 6]
  - a. Charging time will vary. Typical charge time for a battery to go from fully depleted to fully charged is 4-6 hours.
- 6. When your battery is fully charged unplug the charger from the wall outlet or power source.
- 7. Once the charger is unplugged, you can remove the charging cable from the battery.
- 8. Close the rubber charging port cover on the battery to protect the charging port.

## **BATTERY TIPS**

- If you are going to store your bike for a long period of time it is recommended to remove the battery from the bike.
- If you are storing your bike for a long period of time you'll want to charge the battery at least once every 30 days to keep the battery in proper working order.
- When transporting your bike on a bike rack on a vehicle it is recommended to remove the battery from the bike.
- Do not submerge the battery in water or ride the bike in excessively wet conditions.
- If you live in a region that gets colder weather and store your bike in an unheated garage or shed, it is recommended you store the battery indoors to optimize battery life.
- Never leave a charging battery unattended!
