

Minimum requirements for egg labels

Best before

The words "Best Before" must be used and must consist of a day and a month.

Total mass

The minimum total weight of all the eggs in the carton must be displayed clearly.

Nutrition Information Panel

Each egg carton must include a Nutrition Information Panel. Example below is the minimum amount of nutrition information required.

2 points of contact

Two different types of contact information is required, e.g. phone number, e-mail address and physical address. One point of contact can not be a PO box.

Storage

The label must have a recommended storage suggestion.

Number of eggs

GROWN THE WAY

NATURE INTENDED

FREE TO ROAM,

PECK & SCRATCH!

The total number of eggs in the carton must be displayed clearly.

Egg farming system

The carton must clearly state the farming system used. The three recognised farming systems are cage, barn laid and free range.

Density

The stocking density must be clearly stated on the label and for free range eggs, stocking density may not surpass 10,000 hens per hectare.

Produce of Australia label

Egg labels are required to show country of origin. The label should have a minimum of 3mm space around it.
