
# **WET INSTALLTION GUIDE**

# PRINTPEEL&STICK\_


All surfaces must be considered dirty and must be cleaned prior to the application of the vinyl decal. Painted metals should be cleaned with an automotive detergent. Wipe the surface dry with a clean, dry, lint-free cloth.



### 1. Hold in place

Align the decal, line the bottom line of the decal to the bottom side of the door. Apply a vertical length of masking tape through the centre of the decal in preparation for hinging.


For more manageable smaller decals, the masking tape preparation stage is not a necessary.



## 2. Peel back and remove backing

Peel back the application tape which will bring the decal with it. Remove the decals backing by cutting it off at the hinge point.


For more manageable smaller decals, removing all of the backing paper in one go may make fitting easier.



#### 3. Wetting surface


Wet vehicle surface and generously spray adhesive side of vinyl using a spray bottle filled with water.

Please note: We do recommend using an application fluid as it aids the adhesion process.



## 4. Applying decal

Apply the decal while the surface is wet. Applying while the surface is wet allows for flexibility in positioning. With a squeegee, starting at the centre of the decal and working outward, firmly push excess water and air bubbles out. Depending on the temperature, let the decal dry for approximately 5-10 minutes. Cooler temperatures and soapy water method require longer periods of time. Go over with heat gun or hair dryer to speed up drying process if needed.



#### 5. Remove application tape and trim

Remove application tape keeping it flat with the surface. Do this process slowly watching that the decal has applied to the surface correctly. Using a retractable razor blade trim along door openings and fold excess vinyl inward. Ensure that the vinyl graphic has been apllied completely and evenly on the vehicle. Go over the vinyl once more with your squeegee ensuring it's applied.

Repeat instructions for installation on the other side of the vehicle.

Admire your newly installed decal!



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
