

## Failure to follow instructions may result in poor adhesion or ruined decal.

## **Required Equipment:**

- Squeegee (Included)
- Spray bottle with water and a drop or 2 of plain unscented dish soap
- Rubbing Alcohol & a clean microfiber towel
- Heat gun or hair dryer
  - 1. Clean window with rubbing alcohol and dry with a microfiber towel.

## Do not use window cleaner!

Window cleaner will leave residue that prevents adhesion.



- 2. Spray window with soap/water solution.
- 3. Remove white paper backing from decal. Spray soap/water solution onto the sticky side of the decal.
- 4. Apply decal while window and decal are wet. Decal should slide around freely for positioning. Respray if it does not.

Use guides drawn on transfer tape to center decal. You should have an equal gap around all edges.

5. Thoroughly squeegee decal to remove all water and air. <u>Low</u> heat will help adhere decal and dry water.

## Wait 10-15 minutes before removing transfer tape!

Use <u>Low</u> heat and a wet finger and/or squeegee to remove any left over air/bubbles.
