SHADE	FPS	TEMPERATURE	BASE COLOUR	CONSIDERATIONS
Beach Blonde	1 - 111	Slightly Cool	More Neutral Yellow & Green	This is a well-balanced light to medium blonde colour. Darken with Baby Blonde, Light Walnut, or Harvest Brown depending on the deepness that you want to achieve. For additional warmth add Spiced Rum.
Baby Blonde	I - III	Slightly Cool	Warm Yellow & Green	Baby Blonde with brown undertones, can be used alone on moderately cool skin undertones. This shade is a good option for blondes who want a medium taupe eyebrow. An endless range of blondes may be created.
Spiced Rum	I - VI	Medium Warm	More Neutral Yellow Small Part Warm	This is a very versatile medium warm colour. It could be used as a brown colour, as well as an additive to warm up other shades. Caution is advised due to the warm base.
Light Walnut	I - IV	More Neutral	More Neutral Yellow Small Part Warm	This pigment is a good option when you're wanting to achieve a medium brown colour.
Harvest Brown	I - IV	Slightly Warm	More Neutral Yellow Small Part Warm	This is a rich, natural medium brown colour. You can darken this shade using small amounts of Dark Roast or Brooklyn Brown.
Bronze	I - IV	Slightly Warm	More Neutral Yellow Small Part Warm	This is a stunning dark brown colour. This pigment can be used straight without mixing.
Toasted Taupe	I - III	Slightly Warm	Green & Cool Yellow	A dark brown eyebrow colour. Use to obtain a medium to brown-black eyebrow shade.
Perfecto Brown	I - IV	Slightly Cool	Green & Cool Yellow	This is a stunning dark brown colour. This pigment can be used straight without mixing.
Brooklyn Brown	I - VI	Very Cool	Black/Brown	This is a beautiful cool eyebrow colour. For additional warmth, add small amounts of Spiced Rum.
Dark Roast	I - VI	Very Cool	Black/Brown	A dark brown shade. This is a good option for clients who request a dark eyebrow. For additional warmth, add small amounts of Spiced Rum.
