NEW CONSTRUCTION RECOMMENDED INSTALLATION: GARBAGE DISPOSAL AIR SWITCH

I. Rough in the Garbage Disposal, Dishwasher circuit
Install a two-gang box @ sink location instead of a OneGang box, you won't need to install a switch leg or switch above
Counter due to air button system your installing now!

(Notify Plumber to Order Sink with an aytra hole for Air Button)

(Notify Plumber to Order Sink with an extra hole for Air Button unless faucet will mount mono-point & Blank off 3rd hole or use as soap/lotion dispenser location!)

(Set Finish)

- Make up Black lead of air switch to (LINE) dedicated circuit for Garbage Disposal.
- 3. Make up red lead of air switch to (LOAD) garbage disposal receptacle.

 (Extra red wire on air switch not used, remove or cap off)
- 4. Wire dishwasher dedicated circuit to receptacle.
- *Note cut tab on line side of receptacle separating circuits and Recheck all wire connections before mounting devices!
- Mount air switch in Decora insert plate then install with Receptacle in two-Gang box.
- 6. Install finish plate over devices.
- Install Air Button in sink opening apply silicone under lip of button thread locknut on air button from under side of sink.
- 8. Route Air hose from Air switch to Air Button.
- *Operating Load: push Air Button once to turn Appliance on! Push Air Button Again to turn Appliance off!

NEW CONSTRUCTION RECOMMENDED INSTALLATION: EXHAUST FAN AIR SWITCH

- 1. Rough in Exhaust fan in shower location.
- 2. Install one-gang box in accessible location for Air Switch.
- 3. Run switch leg (Load) from Exhaust fan to air switch one-gang box.
- 4. Run power (line) to Air switch location.
- 5. *If desired Air Switch can be wired to a second 3-way switch location, run travelers between the Air Switch and 3-way switch.
- Install Air Line In shower wall @ desired height stub out of wall with Nail Ect the opposite end of airline, stub out with nail wrought below or above one gang box (air switch location).

Air Button & Switch Installation after drywall & tile.

- 7. Install Air Button (Tile installer need to cut/ drill 1-3/8" inch hole in tile for Air Button.) Connect Air hose to back of Air Button; apply silicone under lip of air switch press against tile.
- 8. Make up Air switch black lead to fan (load).
- 9. Make up red wire of air switch to power (Line), second red wire cap off. 10.Attach Air Switch to Decora insert plate then install in one gang box.
- 11. Install finish plate over device.
- 12. Install Air hose onto Air Switch.
- *Note if installing a 3-way switching system connect red wires of air switch to travelers.
- 13. Make up other end of 3-way switching system to power (Line) and travelers, install a 3-way switch & finish plate.
- *Operating Load: push Air Button once to turn Fan on! Push Air Button again to turn Fan off!
- *Operating 3-Way system: Push Air Button once to turn Fan on! Push 3-way Switch to turn Fan off! Push Air Button to turn Fan on again!
