Product Information

The Problem:

Lacquers become matt and weathered over time, often leading to cumbersome polishing work with poor results. Lacquer surfaces are exposed to various weather and environmental impacts that damage the latter in the long run. UV radiation alone causes the lacquer to become matt and lose its gloss. But also the wind and dust or cleaning the car in a car wash leads to matt lacquer surfaces and visible scratches. Conventional products are often incapable of removing the haze; they often even deteriorate the deep gloss while at the same time requiring a high polishing effort!

The Solution:



Product Advantages:

Stronger high gloss - Effectively removes fine scratches - For all paint types and conditions

The improved A1 Speed Polish contains the same high-performance polishing particles used in machining precision mirrors for space research. It achieves maximum surface uniformity and a brilliant mirror finish.

- Effectively removes fine scratches and the greying of painted surfaces due to environmental and weather impact
- Gives paint a brilliant mirror-like finish

- Achieves an extremely smooth surface
- Quick and easy to work with – leaves no streaks or clouding
- Excess product can be wiped off with extreme ease (just like dusting)
- The high-quality carnauba wax protects and seals the paint for up to 3 months
- Solvent-free
- Suitable for polishing machines

Application Areas:

Developed for use on all types of paint (metallic, multi-color, nano and more scratch-proof paints), gloss films and paint conditions (lightly to strongly weathered)

Application:

Wash the car with A1 Speed Shampoo and then dry thoroughly. If there is flash rust, remove it with A1 Flash Rust Remover Gel. Shake bottle well before use. Apply the product onto a dry A1 THE Polish SPONGE (our recommended accessory for optimum product application) and use PRESSURE while rubbing evenly in small circular movements on the clean, dry surface. The more pressure you apply while polishing, the better the result will be. Always keep the A1 THE Polish SPONGE moist and soaked with the product. Add more if necessary. After applying the product to the paint, allow it to dry completely. Simply wipe off any excess product with an A1 THE CLOTH - Premium Microfibre and buff away. Turn over the cloth frequently. Finally, wash the A1 THE Polish SPONGE thoroughly. To achieve a consistent result, it is recommended polishing complete car body parts in one step.

Note: Not suitable for matt paints and matt foils. Do not use on chromed plastic surfaces such as car logos. Do not use in direct sunlight or on hot paint. Store the bottle in a frost-protected place.

Recommendation: We recommend repeating the application 2 to 3 times per year. Abrasive residues on unpainted plastic parts – such as bumpers – can be easily and easily removed with A1 Plastic Protectant matt or shiny. Excellent for cabrio rear plastic windows

Aftercare: To extend the life of the paint, we recommend A1 HIGH END Spray Wax (lasts up to 6 months) or A1 Speed Wax Plus 3 (lasts up to 6 months).
