Sections 17 to 20, and 64
Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Abandoned Brewing Co. Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at Unit 2/794 High Street, Lower Hutt and known as "Abandoned Brewery", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) no alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday - 12.00midday to 8.00pm
- (c) the following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed. The licensee or manager must ensure that:
 - i. alcohol is not sold to intoxicated persons,
 - ii. statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors are observed at all times and evidence of age documents are requested where necessary.
 - iii. signs clearly stating the above requirements be placed at all points of sale.
- (d) drinking water is to be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises from the following location: The point of sale.
- (e) the whole of the premises is designated as a supervised area

Remote Sales

- (f) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- (g) **Alcohol may only be delivered between 6.00am and 11.00pm**
- (h) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours: **at any time on any day**
- (i) In the case of an order made using an internet site the Licensee must:
 - (A) ask the prospective buyer to declare, by ticking an on-screen box, that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and, when a prospective receiver is involved, that the prospective receiver is also 18 years of age or over) -
 - (i) once when the prospective buyer first enters the internet site; and
 - (ii) again, immediately before the sale of any alcohol is completed;
 - (B) refuse to sell alcohol to the prospective buyer unless, on both occasions, he or she declares that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and, where a prospective receiver is involved, also declares that the prospective receiver is 18 years of age or over).
- (j) The Licensee must display on the internet site in a prominent place: the licence holders name, licence number, expiry date and either a legible image of the licence, or a clearly identified link to such and image.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - i. until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - i. until the close of the period of three years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. if it has been renewed, until the close of the period of four years after the day it was issued.
