Denim Blues (MC) 6 balls

(50 grams, 159 meters) per ball]:

Taupe (CC) 2 balls

One Button

Crochet Hook:

Size H-8 (5.0 mm)

or size needed for gauge

SIZE INFORMATION

Finished: 24 x 72" [61 x 183 cm]

GAUGE INFORMATION

16 sc to 4" [10 cm] and Rows 1-10 measure 1.5" [4 cm] using **suggested** hook or any size hook required to obtain the correct gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

ch	chain or chains
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
tr	treble crochet
beg	begin or beginning
sl	slip
sp	space(s)
st(s)	stitch(es)

cm	centimeters

yo	yarn over hook

dtr [Yo] 3 times, insert hook in st and draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] 4 times.

FPtr [Yo] twice, insert hook from front to back to front around indicated st and draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times.

FPdc Yo, insert hook from front to back to front around indicated st and draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using MC, ch 289.

First Half of Pattern:

Row 1: (*right side*) Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each rem ch, turn. (288 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, *sc in next sc, dc in next sc; rep from * to end, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, *sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from * to end, turn.

Rows 5-7: Repeat Row 4.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each st across, changing to CC in last sc, turn. (288 sc)

Do Not cut MC.

Row 9: Ch 2 (counts as 1st hdc, now and throughout), working in *front loop only*, hdc in each rem sc, turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, sl st loosely in each hdc to end, turn.

Fasten off CC.

Row 11: Using MC, working behind last 2 rows, sl st in 1st unused loop of last sc row, sc in same st, sc in each unused loop to end, turn.

Row 12: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end, turn.

Row 13: Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc, now and throughout), dc in each of next 2 sc, *ch 2, skip 1 sc, dc in each of next 2 sc; rep from * to end, turn.

Row 14: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 2 dc, sc in next ch-2 sp; rep from * to last 3 dc, sc in each of next 3 dc, turn. (288 sc)

Rows 15 and 16: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end, turn, changing to CC in last sc of Row 16. Do Not cut MC.

Rows 17-20: Repeat Rows 9-12.

Row 21: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end, turn.

Row 22: Ch 2, hdc in each rem sc to end, turn.

Note: When working FPtr on next row, Do Not work into hdc directly behind FPtr st.

Row 23: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, *FPtr around sc 2 rows below, hdc in each of next 4 sc; rep from * to last st, hdc in last hdc, turn. (288 sts)

Row 24: Ch 1, sc in each st to end, turn.

Row 25: Ch 2, hdc in next sc, *FPdc around next FPtr, hdc in each of next 4 sc; rep from * to last st, hdc in last sc, turn.

Row 26: Ch 1, sc in each st to end, turn.

Row 27: Ch 1, sc in *front loop only* of each sc to end, turn.

Row 28: Ch 1, working in *front loops only* (*unused loops*) of row before previous row, sc in each sc to end, turn.

Row 29: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, [sc in each of next 2 sc, hdc in each of next 2 sc, dc in each of next 2 sc, tr in each of next 2 sc, dtr in each of next 3 sc, tr in each of next 2 sc, dc in each of next 2 sc, hdc in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc] 15 times, sc in last sc, turn. (288 sts)

Row 30: Ch 5 (counts as 1st dtr now and throughout), [dtr in each of next 2 sc, tr in each of next 2 hdc, dc in each of next 2 dc, hdc in each of next 2 tr, sc in each of next 3 dtr, hdc in each of next 2 tr, dc in each of next 2 dc, tr in each of next 2 hdc, dtr in each of next 2 sc] 15 times, dtr in each of last 2 sc, changing to CC in last st, turn.

Drop MC, but Do Not cut.

Row 31: (*right side*) Sc in each st across. Do Not Turn, drop CC but Do Not cut.

Row 32: With right side facing, using MC, rep Row 29.

Row 33: With wrong side facing, using CC, ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 34: Using CC, ch 1, sc in each sc to end, turn. Fasten off CC.

Row 35: (*wrong side*) Using MC, rep Row 30, but Do Not Turn.

Row 36: With wrong side facing, join CC with a sc in first st, sc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off CC.

Row 37: (*right side*) Using MC, rep Row 29.

Row 38: Repeat Row 30, but Do Not change colors.

Row 39: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 40: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 41: (*right side*) Ch 1, sc in *front loop only* each sc across, turn.

Row 42: Ch 1, working in *front loops only (unused loops)* of row before previous row, sc in each sc to end, turn.

Rows 43 and 44: Repeat Rows 13 and 14.

Row 45: Repeat Row 4.

Repeat Row 4 until piece measures 13" [33 cm] from beg, ending after a wrong side row.

Second Half of Pattern:

Note: For this half of pattern, row numbers given for repeats refer to **First Half of Pattern** rows.

Rows 1 and 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 3 and 4: Repeat Rows 13 and 14.

Rows 5-16: Repeat Rows 27-38.

Rows 17 and 18: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 19 and 20: Repeat Rows 27 and 28.

Rows 21-26: Repeat Rows 21-26, changing to CC in last st of Row 26.

Rows 27-38: Repeat Rows 9-20.

Rows 39-43: Repeat Rows 3-7.

Row 44: Ch 1, sc in each st across, Do Not Turn at end of row.

Border:

First End:

Row 1: With wrong side facing, working in ends of rows, sc evenly to next corner, turn. Do Not sc in raised, ridge sts, such as Rows 9 and 10, sc only in base of sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc to next corner. Fasten off.

Second End:

Row 1: With wrong side facing, working on opposite short side, join MC with a sc in 1st row, sc evenly in ends of rows as before, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end. Fasten off.

Weave in all ends.

Lacing:

Using CC, ch 3, leaving a long tail.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook, Do Not Turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, yo, insert hook from front to back between skipped ch and last dc made and draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice (dc made), Do Not Turn.

Row 3: Repeat as Row 2, working between ch-2 and last dc made. When lacing is 20" [51 cm] long, weave beg tail through ch-2 sps of Row 13 (starting on either short side). Continue to make lacing longer, weaving through sps as you work, until beg end of Lacing reaches opposite short end.

Continue to work Lacing until it is about 5" [12.5 cm] longer than wrap. Do Not fasten off Lacing yet.

Try on Wrap and use safety pins to mark desired placement for button and for fastening loop of lacing.

On model shown, button was sewn 24" [61 cm] from one end, and fastening loop 16" [40.5 cm] from opposite end.

Sew button in place securely.

Pull the Lacing away from Wrap at correct spot about 2.5" [6.5 cm] from wrap (making a 5" [12.5 cm] loop).

Adjust if necessary, so loop fits easily around button, but is not too loose.

At fastening, twist loop once at the base, and use CC to sew in place securely, including the twist.

This will hold button more closely.

Lay Wrap flat, and be sure rem lacing is evenly spaced, not pulling too tightly or laying too loosely. If necessary, add or take out some rows for correct length, until Lacing just reaches end. Fasten off.

Use beg and ending tails to sew Lacing securely at each end.
