

SHOPPING LIST

Yarn (Bulky Weight)



Mary Maxim Studio

[3.5 ounces, 164 yards

(100 grams, 150 meters) per ball]:

Pottery (MC) 2 balls

Cobalt Glass (CC) 2 balls

Knitting Needles

Size 10 (6.00 mm)

or size needed for gauge

SIZE INFORMATION

Finished: 9 x 58" [23 x 147.5 cm]

GAUGE INFORMATION

4 sts and 6 rows to 1" [2.5 cm]

measured over Stocking stitch using

suggested needles or any size needles which will give the correct gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

k knit

p purl

cm centimeters

mm millimeters

beg beg or beginning

inc increase or increasing

dec decrease or decreasing

rem remain or remaining

rep repeat or repeating

st(s) stitch(es)

tog together



kfb Knit into front and back of next st (inc one st).

ssk Slip next 2 sts knitwise, one at a time, to right needle, then insert left needle through fronts of both sts and k2tog through back loops (dec one st).

Notes:

Cowl shown is long enough to be looped around neck twice. Due to the nature of this yarn, each cowl will have its own unique color sequence.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using MC, cast on 28 sts.

Base Triangles:

Row 1: (wrong side) P2, turn.

Row 2: (right side) K2, turn.

Row 3: P3, turn.

Row 4: K3, turn.

Row 5: P4, turn.

Row 6: K4, turn.

Row 7: P5, turn.

Row 8: K5, turn.

Row 9: P6, turn.

Row 10: K6, turn.

Row 11: P7, Do Not turn.

Repeat Rows 1-11 three times more - 4 Base Triangles worked. Turn work.

Right Hand Corner Triangle:

Using CC, work as follows:

Row 1: (right side) K2, turn.

Row 2: (wrong side) P2, turn.

Row 3: Kfb, ssk, turn.

Row 4: P3, turn.

Row 5: Kfb, k1, ssk, turn.

Row 6: P4, turn.

Row 7: Kfb, k2, ssk, turn.

Row 8: P5, turn.

Row 9: Kfb, k3, ssk, turn.

Row 10: P6, turn.

Row 11: Kfb, k4, ssk, Do Not turn.

Right Hand Corner Triangle is complete, 7 sts rem on right hand needle.

Right Side Rectangles:

**Pick-up Row: (right side)* Pick up and k7 sts evenly along edge of next triangle/rectangle, turn.

Row 1: (wrong side) P7, turn.

Row 2: (right side) K6, ssk with last st of rectangle and first st of next triangle/rectangle, turn.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 six times more, Do Not turn work at end of last row.*

Repeat from * to * twice more - 3 Right Side Rectangles worked.

Left Hand Corner Triangle:

Pick-up Row: (right side) Pick up and k7 sts evenly along edge of last triangle/rectangle, turn.

Row 1: (wrong side) P2tog, p5, turn.

Row 2: (right side) K6, turn.

Row 3: P2tog, p4, turn.

Row 4: K5, turn.

Row 5: P2tog, p3, turn.

Row 6: K4, turn.

Row 7: P2tog, p2, turn.

Row 8: K3, turn.

Row 9: P2tog, p1, turn.

Row 10: K2, turn.

Row 11: Using MC, p2tog, Do Not turn.

Left Hand Corner Triangle is complete, one st rem on right hand needle.

Wrong Side Rectangles:

Pick-up Row: (wrong side) Pick up and p6 sts evenly along edge of triangle just worked, turn.

***Row 1: (right side)* K7, turn.

Row 2: (wrong side) P6, p2tog with last st of rectangle and first st of next triangle/rectangle, turn.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 six times more, Do Not turn at end of last row.

Next Row: Pick up and p7 sts evenly along edge of next rectangle, turn.**

Repeat from ** to ** 3 times more - 4 Wrong Side Rectangles worked.

Continue in established pattern of Right Hand Corner Triangle, Right Side Rectangles, Left Hand Corner Triangle and Wrong Side Rectangles until Cowl is about 56.5" [143.5 cm] long (or desired length), ending with a Left Hand Corner Triangle. Cowl shown uses MC for the End Triangles.

End Triangles:

****Pick-up Row: (wrong side)* Pick up and p6 sts evenly along edge of triangle just worked/next rectangle, turn.

Row 1: (right side) K7, turn.

Row 2: (wrong side) P2tog, p4, p2tog, turn.

Row 3: K6, turn.

Row 4: P2tog, p3, p2tog, turn.

Row 5: K5, turn.

Row 6: P2tog, p2, p2tog, turn.

Row 7: K4, turn.

Row 8: P2tog, p1, p2tog, turn.

Row 9: K3, turn.

Row 10: [P2tog] twice, turn.

Row 11: K2, turn.

Row 12: [P2tog] twice, pass first st over second st - one st rem on right hand needle, Do Not turn.***

Repeat from *** to *** 3 times more - 4 End Triangles worked.

Fasten off last st.

Sew short ends together to form Cowl.

Weave in all ends.
