

SHOPPING LIST

Yarn (DK/Sport Weight)



Mary Maxim Prism

[3.5 ounces, 290 yards

(100 grams, 265 meters) per ball]:

Size Sm/Med 5 balls

Size Lge/2XL 7 balls

Knitting Needles:

32" (80 cm) Circular Needle

Size 6 (4.0 mm)

or size needed for gauge

SIZE INFORMATION

XS/Med: 36 x 38.5" [91.5 x 97.5 cm]

Lge/2XL: 44 x 47.5" [111.5 x 120.5 cm]

GAUGE INFORMATION

One pattern rep (25 sts) to 4" [10 cm] and 24 rows (one pattern rep) to 3" [8 cm] using **suggested** needle or any size needle which will give the correct gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

beg	begin or beginning
k	knit
p	purl
cm	centimeters
dec	decrease or decreasing
inc	increase or increasing
rem	remain or remaining
rep	repeat or repeating
st(s)	stitch(es)
sl	slip
tog	together
yo	yarn over



Pattern: (worked over 25 sts)

Row 1: (*right side*) K 12, k2tog, k 11, yo.

Row 2: *P1, yo, p 10, p2tog, k 12.

Row 3: *P 12, k2tog, k9, yo, k2.

Row 4: *P3, yo, p8, p2tog, p 12.

Row 5: *K 12, k2tog, k7, yo, k4.

Row 6: *P5, yo, p6, p2tog, k 12.

Row 7: *P 12, k2tog, k5, yo, k6.

Row 8: *P7, yo, p4, p2tog, p 12.

Row 9: *K 12, k2tog, k3, yo, k8.

Row 10: *P9, yo, p2, p2tog, k 12.

Row 11: *P 12, k2tog, k1, yo, k 10.

Row 12: *P 11, yo, p2tog, p 12.

Row 13: *Yo, k 11, k2tog, k 12.

Row 14: *K 12, p2tog, p 10, yo, p1.

Row 15: *K2, yo, k9, k2tog, p 12.

Row 16: *P 12, p2tog, p8, yo, p3.

Row 17: *K4, yo, k7, k2tog, k 12.

Row 18: *K 12, p2tog, p6, yo, p5.

Row 19: *K6, yo, k5, k2tog, p 12.

Row 20: *P 12, p2tog, p4, yo, p7.

Row 21: *K8, yo, k3, k2tog, k 12.

Row 22: *K 12, p2tog, p2, yo, p9.

Row 23: *K 10, yo, k1, k2tog, p 12.

Row 24: *P 12, p2tog, yo, p 11.

Repeat these 24 rows for pattern.

Note: Be sure to keep cast on and cast off loose, as these 2 edges form the outside circumference which lays around the neck and drapes down the body. If these are too tight, the Shrug will not lay flat at the back and the front edges will not come forward to front of body.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 227(252) sts loosely.

Do not join in round, but work back and forth on circular needle as follows:

Work in Garter st (every row k) and having first row as a right side row, until piece measures 2"[5 cm], ending after a wrong side row.

Now work in pattern as follows:

Row 1: (*right side*) K1, work Row 1 of Pattern to last st, k1.

Row 2: P1, work Row 2 of Pattern to last st, p1.

Continue in this manner, working correct row of Pattern and keeping the first and last st in St st (one row k, one row p), until piece measures

36.5(45.5)" [92.5(115.5) cm] from cast on edge, ending after a wrong side row.

Work in Garter st over all sts for 2" [5 cm].

Cast off loosely knitwise.

To Complete: Fold piece in half lengthwise, wrong sides tog, bringing cast off to meet cast on edge, having fold at top.

Place a marker 7(8)" [18(20.5) cm]

up from bottom edge on each side.

Sew seams from open end to marker, leaving work above marker open for armholes.

Weave in all ends
