SIZE INFORMATION

10"[25.5 cm] tall

GAUGE INFORMATION

18 sts and 24 rows to 4" [10 cm] measured over Stocking stitch, using **suggested larger** needles or any size needles which will give the correct stitch gauge.



DPN Double Point Needles

k1f&b Knit into front and back of next stitch

C4B Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold to back of work, k2 from left-hand needle, then k2 from cable needle

C4F Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold to front of work, k2 from left-hand needle, then k2 from cable needle

C6F Slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold to front of work, k3 from left-hand needle, then k3 from cable needle

ssk Slip next 2 sts knitwise, one at a time, to right-hand needle, insert left-hand needle through fronts of both sts, from back to front and k2tog as usual

INSTRUCTIONS

Using DPN's and Color 1, cast on 16 sts (4 sts each needle). Join in rnd, being careful not to

twist sts.

Now work in pattern over *each*needle as follows:

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: K1f&B in each st - 8 sts each needle (32 sts).

Rnd 3: Knit.

Rnd 4: K1f&B in each st - 16 sts each needle (64 sts).

Rnds 5-7: Knit.

Rnd 8: K1, k1f&b - 24 each needle (96 sts).

Rnd 9: K6, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k8, [p1, k1] twice, p1.

Rnd 10: K6, [k1, p1] twice, k1, C4B, C4F, [k1, p1] twice, k1.

Rnd 11: K6, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k8, [p1, k1] twice, p1.

Rnd 12: K6, [k1, p1] twice, k 10, [p1, k1] twice.

Rnd 13: K6, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k8, [p1, k1] twice, p1.

Rnd 14: K6, [k1, p1] twice, k1, C4F, C4B, k1, [p1, k1] twice.

Rnd 15: C6F, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k8, [p1, k1] twice, p1.

Rnd 16: K6, [k1, p1] twice, k 10, [p1, k1] twice.

Now rep Rnds 9-16 twice more, then rep Rnds 9-10 once.

Rnd 35: K5, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, k6, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, [k4, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, k6, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog] twice,

k4, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, k6, ssk, k1, p1, k1, slip the last st to first needle for next rnd - 81 sts.

Rnd 36: K2tog, k5, p1, k1, p1, k8, *p1, k1, p1, k6, p1, k1, p1, k8; rep from * twice more, p1, k1, p1 - 20 sts each needle (80 sts).

Now continue in pattern on each needle as follows:

Rnd 37: K7, p1, k10, p1, k1.

Rnd 38: K6, p1, k1, p1, C4B, C4F, p1, k1, p1.

Rnd 39: C6F, k1, p1, k 10, p1, k1. Rnd 40: K6, p1, k1, p1, k8, p1, k1, p1.

Rnd 41: K7, p1, k 10, p1, k1. Rnd 42: K6, p1, k1, p1, C4F, C4B, p1, k1, p1. **Rnd 43:** K7, p1, k 10, p1, k1. **Rnd 44:** K6, p1, k1, p1, k8, p1, k1, p1.

Rnd 45: K7, p1, k10, p1, k1. Rnd 46: K6, p1, k1, p1, C4B, C4F, p1, k1, p1.

Rnd 47: C6F, k1, p1, k 10, p1, k1. Rnd 48: K2tog, k2, ssk, p1, k1, p1, k8, p1, k1, p1 - 18 sts each needle (72 sts). Rnd 49: K4, p1, k 10, p1, k1.

Rnd 50: K4, p1, k1, p1, C4F, C4B, p1, k1, p1.

Rnd 51: K5, p1, k 10, p1, k1.

Rnd 52: K4, p1, k1, p1, k8, p1, k1, p1.

Rnd 53: K5, p1, k 10, p1, k1.

Rnd 54: K4, p1, k1 p1, C4B, C4F, p1, k1, p1.

Rnd 55: C4F, k1, p1, k 10, p1, k1. Rnd 56: K4, p1, k1, p1, k8, p1, k1, p1. Rnd 57: K2, [k2tog] 7 times, k2 - 11 sts each needle (44 sts).

Stuff body to desired fullness.

Rnds 58 and 60: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Rnds 59 and 61: *P1, k1; rep from * around.

Rnd 62: As Rnd 57, but k1f&b in first and last st on each needle -13 sts each needle (52 sts).

Rnds 63, 65, 67 and 69: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Rnds 64, 66, 68 and 70: *P1, k1; rep from * around.

Rnd 71: *K2tog, k1, [p1, k1] 4 times, p2tog, k2tog, p1, [k1, p1] 4 times, p2tog; rep from * once more - 11 sts each needle (44 sts).

Rnds 72, 74, 76 and 78: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Rnds 73, 75 and 77: *P1, k1; rep from * around.

Rnd 79: *P2tog, k1, [p1, k1] 3 times, p2tog, k2tog, p1, [k1, p1] 3 times, k2tog; rep from * once more - 9 sts each needle (36 sts).

Rnd 80: *K1, p1; rep from * around. Rnd 81: *P1, k1; rep from * around. Rnd 82: *K2tog; rep from * around - 18 sts rem.

Stuff remainder of neck and head to desired fullness.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

Face: (use color picture as a guide) Decide which area of the body will become the front of the Snowlady. Determine placement of eyes on center front of head, then sew or glue each button in place as desired. To make the nose, take the piece of orange felt and bring one corner up diagonally to meet opposite corner, forming a triangle (as shown at right). Draw a slight half circle about 2" [5 cm] above one tip. Cut along this line. Roll the cut piece to form a cone. Using a crafting glue (or hot gun if desired), glue the edges together securely. Allow to dry. Then apply glue to the open end of the cone and glue nose to face of snowlady, below eyes, as desired.

Scarf:

Using straight needles and Color 2, cast on 8 sts.

Work in Garter st (every row knit), until scarf measures 22" [56 cm] from cast on edge. Cast off knitwise.

Fringe: Cut 16 pieces of Color 2, each being 3" [7.5 cm] in length.
Using 2 pieces for each fringe, knot 4 fringe spaced evenly across each short end of scarf.
Trim ends to neaten.

Beret:

Using straight needles and Color 2, cast on 60 sts.

Rows 1-4: *K2, p2; rep from * across. Row 5: K1f&b in each st across - 120 sts. Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: Knit.

Repeat these last 2 rows 3 times more, then Row 6 once.

To Shape Crown:

Row 15: *K 10, k2 tog; rep from * aross - 110 sts.

Row 16 and every alternate row:

Purl.

Row 17: *K9, k2tog; rep from * across - 100 sts.

Row 19: *K8, k2tog; rep from * across - 90 sts.

Row 21: *K7, k2tog; rep from * across

- 80 sts.

Row 23: *K6, k2tog; rep from * across - 70 sts.

Row 25: *K5, k2tog; rep from * across

Row 27: *K4, k2tog; rep from * across - 50 sts.

Row 29: *K3, k2tog; rep from * across - 40 sts.

Row 31: *K2, k2tog; rep from * across - 30 sts.

Row 33: *K1, k2tog; rep from * across - 20 sts.

Row 34: Purl.

Row 35: *K2tog; rep from * across - 10 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail.

Thread tail through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

Now using tail, sew back seam of Beret. Weave in all ends.


To Complete:


Wrap scarf around neck of Snowlady and knot in place.

Sew Beret on top of head.

If desired, tack Beret in place.

Directions for making Nose





mark off a line 2"
[5 cm] from tip and cut.
