#### Yarns (Worsted Weight)

[6 ounces, 315 yards

(170 grams, 288 meters) per skein]:

White (MC) 1 skein

Mary Maxim Ultra Mellowspun

[1.75 ounces, 160 yards

(50 grams, 146 meters) per ball]:

Blue (CC 1) 35 yards

Aqua (CC 2) 1 ball

Mary Maxim Sparkle

White (CC 3) 120 yards

Black Buttons 4

White Chenille Stem

Orange Felt

Also required, not included

polyfill (stuffing)

hot glue gun

#### Crochet hooks:

Size H-8 (5.00 mm)

or size needed to obtain gauge



### STITCH GUIDE

**sc2tog** [Insert hook in next sc and draw up a loop] twice, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**FPdc** Yo, insert hook from front to back to front, around post of next dc and draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

**BPdc** Yo, insert hook from back to front to back, around post of next dc and draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

### INSTRUCTIONS

**Body:** (make 2)

Using MC, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Do not join but work in continuous rnds, placing a marker at beg of each rnd.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each sc around - 12 sc.

**Rnds 3 and 4:** (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around - 18 (27) sc.

**Rnds 5 and 6:** (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around - 36 (48) sc.

### SIZE INFORMATION

8" [20.5 cm] tall, measured from bottom of body to top of head..

### GAUGE INFORMATION

8 sc and 8 rows to 2" [5 cm] measured over single crochet using MC yarn only and the **suggested** hook or any size hook which will give the correct stitch gauge or tension.

**Rnds 7-22:** Sc in each sc around.

**Rnd 23:** (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc2tog) around - 40 sc.

**Rnds 24-26:** Sc in each sc around.

**Rnd 27:** (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc2tog) around - 30 sc.

**Rnd 28:** Sc in each sc around.

**Rnd 29:** (Sc in next sc, sc2tog) around - 20 sc.

**Rnd 30:** Sc in each sc around.

Stuff body to desired fullness.

Now before going any further, cut a piece of MC about 20" [51 cm] in length from the unused end of the skein for later use.

### Head:

**Rnd 1:** (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around - 25 sc.

**Rnd 2:** Sc in next sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around - 37 sc.

**Rnd 3:** (joining rnd) Working in back loops only, sc in each sc around.

**Rnds 4-10:** Sc in each sc around.

Fold Rnd 3 of the Head down to meet the Body and using the cut piece of MC, working into the unused loops of Rnd 3, sew the 2 pieces tog.

This forms a nice shape and gives more support to the neck area. Stuff head to desired firmness to this point. Now continue Head, stuffing as you work.

**Rnd 11:** (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc2tog) around, sc in each of last 2 sc - 30 sc.

**Rnd 12:** Sc in each sc around.

**Rnd 13:** (Sc in next sc, sc2tog) around - 20 sc.

**Rnd 14:** Sc in each sc around.

**Rnd 15:** (Sc2tog) around - 10 sc.

**Rnd 16:** Sc in each sc around.

Break yarn and fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Finish stuffing head. Weave tail through each of rem 10 sc, draw up tightly to close head and fasten off securely.

Weave in end.

**Arms for Boy:** Using MC, ch 2, leaving a long tail for sewing.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Do not join but work in continuous rnds, placing a marker at beg of each rnd.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each sc around - 12 sc.

**Rnd 3:** (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around - 15 sc.

**Rnds 4-20:** Sc in each sc around.

**Rnd 21:** [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 5 times - 10 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Weave tail through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

Place a small amount of stuffing in "hand".

Using long tail at beg of arm, weave through beg ch, draw up tightly and fasten off securely

Make a second arm the same.

Attach an arm securely to each side of Body, at joining rnd.

**Arms for Girl:** Work as given for Boy's Arms through Rnd 14.

**Rnd 15:** Sc in next sc, (sc2tog) around - 8 sc.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail.

Now complete as given for Boys Arms.

### To Complete:

Determine placement of eyes on center front of head. Using the ball shaped buttons for eyes, sew each in place as desired.

**To make the nose:** Cut 2 pieces from the orange felt, each being 2.5" [6.5 cm] square.

Take one square and draw a slight half circle about 1.5" [4 cm] above one tip, from corner to corner. Cut along this line. Roll the cut piece to form a cone. Using a crafting glue (or hot gun if desired), glue the edges together securely.

Allow to dry. Then apply glue to the open end of the cone and glue nose to face of one baby, below eyes, as desired.

Repeat with 2nd square.

### Hat:

**Note:** The hat is worked using one strand of CC 3 together with a strand of either CC 1 or CC 2.

When changing colors, drop the strand indicated and pick up the opposite color and continue in pattern.

Carry the unused colors along side edge of work neatly.

**To Make:** Using a strand of CC 1 and CC 3 held tog, ch 17.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn - 15 dc.

Now from this point on, work through back loops only.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn - 15 sc.

Drop strand of CC 1 (do not cut yarn), and pick up strand of CC 2 and one strand of CC 3 together, continue.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, dc in next sc and each sc across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each dc across, turn. Drop CC 2 (do not cut yarn), and pick up CC 1.

**Rows 5 and 6:** Repeat Rows 3 and 4.

Drop CC 1 and pick up CC 2.

**Rows 7 and 8:** Repeat Rows 3 and 4.

Drop CC 2 and pick up CC 1.

**Rows 9-20:** Repeat Rows 5-8 three times more.

Now bring beg ch around to meet last row worked and working through both thicknesses, sc ends tog to form back seam. Fasten off all colors.

Cut a 4" [10 cm] length of CC 1.

Now working along end where yarn was carried along side, weave piece through ends of rows, beg and ending at back seam.



Draw ends tog tightly and fasten off securely to gather top of hat closed.

Weave in ends neatly.

**Pompoms:** (make 3)

Cut two 6" [15 cm] lengths of CC 1 and one length of CC 2. Set aside for the moment.

Using a strand of both CC 1 and CC 3, wrap both strands around 2 fingers 12 times. Take one length of CC 1 and tie tightly around center of wraps.

Remove fingers. Cut loops on both ends. Trim ends to neaten.

Leave tails from ties for the moment.

Make one more pompom the same, using CC 2 and CC 3 together.

Wrap length of CC 2 around wraps.

Make a 3rd pompom the same, but using one strand each of CC 1, CC 2 and CC 3.

Wrap length of CC 1 around center of wraps.

**To Complete:** Braid the lengths from each pompom tog, or simply tie them tog as desired. Thread ends down through top of hat and sew securely in place. Vary the length of strands to each pompom or pull them tight to top of hat if desired.

**Scarf:** Using one strand of CC 3 and one strand of CC 2 tog, ch 51.

**Row 1:** Dc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch to end, dropping CC 2 and joining CC 1 in last st, turn - 50 dc.

**Row 2:** Using CC 3 and CC 1 tog, ch 2, [FPdc around post of next dc, BPdc around post of next dc] 24 times, hdc in last st. Fasten off both colors.

Weave in all ends.

**To Complete Boy Snowbaby:**

Fold bottom edge of hat up to form brim. Place hat on head and if desired, tack hat in place.

Wrap scarf around neck as desired.

**Snowball:** (see color picture)

Cut a 4" [10 cm] length of CC 2 and set aside for the moment.

Using one strand of CC 3 and one strand of CC 2, wrap around 2 fingers 40 times.

Knot the cut length of CC 2 around center of wraps securely.

Remove fingers and cut loops on both ends. Trim ends to form a nice round pompom.

Using tails from the center tie, sew the snowball to inside of each boy's hand.

**Girls Poncho:** (make 2 pieces the same)

Use one strand of CC 3 and one strand of CC 2 held tog throughout unless otherwise stated.

Ch 10.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn - 9 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), working in back loops only, dc in each rem dc to end, turn - 9 dc.

Repeat this last row 11 times more.

**Next Row:** Ch 1, working in both loops, sc in each dc across. Fasten off.

**To Assemble:** Sew these 2 pieces tog as shown in Diagram below.

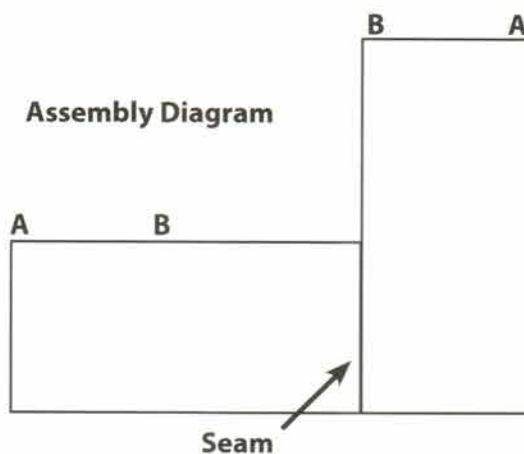
Sew first seam (marked seam), then sew second seam, bringing end of one piece around to side of other piece, matching A to A and B to B.

**Collar:** Using one strand of MC and one strand of CC 3 tog, beg at center back, join with a sl st.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, work 15 sc evenly along each side of neck opening, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 30 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, (yo, insert hook and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice in next sc, yo and draw through all 3 loops - **Bobble made**,

\*sc in each of next 2 sc, Bobble in next sc; rep from \* around, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 10 Bobbles.



**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.  
Weave in ends.  
Turn collar down to outside and tack in place loosely.  
Slip over head, watching the nose.

**To Complete Girl Snowbaby:**

**Earmuffs:** Take the chenille stem and wind it around a pencil or pen. Remove and leave to one side for the moment. This curly piece will form the band of the Earmuffs.

**Pompoms:** (make 2)

Cut 2 lengths of CC 2, each being 4" [10 cm] long and set aside for the moment. Using one strand of CC 3 and one strand of CC 2, wrap around 2 fingers 30 times.  
Take one length of CC 2 and knot tightly around center of wraps.  
Remove fingers and cut through loops at both ends. Trim ends to neaten.  
Repeat for 2nd pompom.

Sew a pompom to each side of the girl snowman's head securely.  
Now take the chenille band and bend slightly, adjusting to fit over top of head, and sew or glue each end in place behind each pompom.
