Size J-10 (6.00 mm)

or size needed for gauge

### SIZE INFORMATION

**Finished:** 28 x 30" [129.5 x 165 cm]

### GAUGE INFORMATION

7 dc and 4 rows to 2" [5 cm] using **suggested** hook or any size hook which will give the correct stitch gauge or tension.

<b>dc</b>	double crochet
<b>dec</b>	decrease or decreasing

### INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 97.

**Row 1:** (right side) Dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped ch count as 1st dc), ch 1, skip next ch,

\*dc in each of next 9 ch, ch 1, skip next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, dc in each of last 2 ch, turn. (86 dc)  
**Row 2:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, skip next dc, \*dc in each of next 7 dc, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, skip next dc; rep from \* to last dc, dc in last dc, turn. (76 dc)

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), (dc, ch 1) in each of next 2 ch-1 sps, skip next dc, \*dc in each of next 5 dc, (ch 1, dc) in each of next 2 ch-1 sps, # ch 1, skip next dc; rep from \* across, ending last rep at #, dc in last dc, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 4, (dc, ch 1) in each of next 2 ch-1 sps, skip next dc, \*dc in each of next 3 dc, ch 1, # (dc, ch 1) in each of next 3 ch-1 sps, skip next dc; rep from \* ending last rep at #, (dc, ch 1) in each of next 2 ch-1 sps, skip next dc, dc in last dc, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 3, [dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc] three times, ch 1, skip next dc, \*dc in next dc, [dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc] 4 times, ch 1, skip next dc; rep from \* to last 7 sts, dc in next dc, [dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc] 3 times, turn.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, dc in each of next 5 dc, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, skip next dc, \*dc in each of next 7 dc, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, skip next dc; rep from \* to last 6 sts, dc in each of last 6 sts, turn.

**Row 7:** Ch 3, dc in each of next 4 dc, \*ch 1, (dc, ch 1) in each of next 2 ch-1 sps, skip next dc, dc in each of next 5 dc; rep from \* across, turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 dc, \*ch 1, (dc, ch 1) in each of next 3 ch-1 sps, skip next dc, dc in each of next 3 dc; rep from \* to last dc, dc in last dc, turn.

**Row 9:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, \*dc in next dc, [dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc] 4 times, ch 1, skip next dc; rep from \* to last 2 dc, dc in each of rem 2 dc, turn.

**Rows 10-53:** Rep Rows 2-9 five times, then rep Rows 2-5 once more. Fasten off.

#### **Border:**

**Rnd 1:** With right side facing, join yarn in upper right hand corner, ch 7 (counts as dc, ch 4), dc in same corner st, \*ch 3, skip next dc or ch-1 sp, dc in next dc or ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next dc or ch-1 sp; rep from \* to corner, adjusting skipped sts if necessary to

end with (ch 3, dc in corner st), ch 4, dc in same corner st, now working in sides of rows, \*\*ch 3, dc in end of next row, ch 1, dc in end of next row; rep from \*\* to corner, adjusting dc's if necessary to end with (ch 3, dc in corner), ch 4, dc in same corner st; rep from \* around, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 7.

**Rnd 2:** Sl st into ch-4 sp, ch 1, work (sc, hdc, Picot, hdc, sc) in next ch-4 sp, \*(sc, hdc, Picot, hdc, sc) in next ch-3 sp, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to last sp before corner, work from ( to ) in each of next (ch-3 sp, ch-4 sp, ch-3 sp), sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, join with sl st in 1st sc. Fasten off.

Weave in all ends.
