GAUGE INFORMATION

18 sts and 24 rows to 4" [10 cm]

measured over Stocking stitch and Cable panel of 20 sts measures 2.75" [7 cm] wide using **suggested larger** needles or any size needles which will give the correct gauge.

just worked and knit into back of loop.
W&T Bring yarn to back of work, slip
next st purlwise to right needle, take
yarn to front of work, slip st back to left
needle, turn work.
When working back over wrapped
sts, insert right needle under the wrap
and through next st on left needle and
work together the wrap and the st (the
wrap will fall behind the st).

Cable Panel: (worked over 20 sts)

Row 1: (right side) P2, k4, C4B, C4F, k4, p2.

Row 2: K2, p 16, k2.

Row 3: P2, k2, C4B, k4, C4F, k2, p2.

Row 4: K2, p 16, k2.

Row 5: P2, C4B, k8, C4F, p2.

Row 6: K2, p 16, k2.

Repeat these 6 rows for Cable Panel.

INSTRUCTIONS

Back: Using smaller needles, cast on 97(105, 115, 123) sts and work in ribbing as follows:

Row 1: (right side) K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2: P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Repeat these 2 rows 8 times more, 9 times in all (18 rows = 3" [7.5 cm]).

Change to larger needles and continue as follows:

Next Row: (right side) Knit, dec 11 sts evenly across - 86(94, 104, 112) sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Continue in St st (one row k, one row p), AND AT THE SAME TIME, dec as follows:

Next Row: K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, sl 1, k1, pssso, k2.

Work 3 rows even.

Repeat these last 4 rows 3 times more.

Next Row: K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, sl 1, k1, pssso, k2.

Next Row: Purl.

Repeat these last 2 rows until 70(80, 88, 98) sts rem. Now work even in St st until piece measures 8(8.25, 8.5, 8.75)" [20.5(21, 21.5, 22) cm] from cast on edge, ending after a wrong side row.

Next Row: K 25(30, 34, 39) sts, PM, work Row 1 of Cable Panel over next 20 sts, PM, k 25(30, 34, 39) sts.

Next Row: P to marker, sl M, work Row 2 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p to end.

Continue to work in pattern until Cable Panel has been worked 3 times - 18 rows in all, ending with Row 6. Now beg with a k row, work in St st over all sts, inc one st at each end of the 3rd row, then every alternate row following until there are 82(92, 100, 108) sts on the needle.

Work even in St st until piece measures 17.5" [44.5 cm] from cast on edge, ending after a wrong side row.

To Shape Armholes:

Cast off 4(5, 6, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows - 74(82, 88, 94) sts.

Next Row: K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, sl 1, k1, pssso, k2.

Next Row: Purl.

Repeat these 2 rows until 68(74, 78, 80) sts rem.

Work even in St st until armhole measures 7.5(8, 8.5, 9)" [19(20.5, 21.5, 23) cm] from cast off, ending after a wrong side row.

Cast off 17(19, 20, 21) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Place rem 34(36, 38, 38) sts on st holder for back neck.

Sleeves: Using smaller needles, cast on 37(41, 43, 45) sts and work ribbing as given for Back, until band measures 8" [20.5 cm], ending after a Row 2 and dec 0(0, 1, 1) st in center of last rib row - 37(41, 42, 44) sts.

Change to larger needles and beg with a k row, work in St st, inc one st at each end of the 5th row, then on every following 4th row 2(2, 3, 3) times, then on every 6th row following until there are 63(67, 72, 76) sts on the needle.

Work even in St st until sleeve measures 13.5(14, 14.5, 15)" [34(35.5, 37, 38) cm] from top of ribbing, ending after a p row.

To Shape Cap: Cast off 4(5, 6, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows - 55(57, 60, 62) sts.

Next Row: K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1.

Next Row: Purl.

Repeat these last 2 rows 5(8, 9, 11) times more - 43(39, 40, 38) sts rem. Now cast off 2 sts at beg of every row following until 15(15, 16, 16) sts rem. Cast off rem sts.

Left Front: Using larger needles, cast on 21(21, 22, 22) sts.

Next Row: K2(2, 3, 3), PM, p2, k12, p2, PM, k3.

Next Row: P3, sl M, k2, p4, [inc one st in next st purlwise] 4 times, p4, k2, sl M, p to end - 25(25, 26, 26) sts.

****Next Row:** K to marker, incl, sl M, work Row 1 of Cable Panel over next 20 sts, sl M, k3 - 26(26, 27, 27) sts.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Row 2 of Cable Panel, sl M, W&T.

Short Row: Sl M, work Row 3 of Cable Panel, sl M, k3.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Row 4 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p to end - 26(26, 27, 27) sts.

Next Row: K to M, incl, sl M, work Row 5 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, k3 - 27(27, 28, 28) sts.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Row 6 of Cable Panel, sl M, W&T.

Short Row: Work Row 1 of Cable Panel, sl M, k3.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Row 2 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p to end - 27(27, 28, 28) sts.

Next Row: K2, incl, k to marker, incl, sl M, work Row 3 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, k3 - 29(29, 30, 30) sts.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Row 4 of Cable Panel, sl M, W&T.

Short Row: Work Row 5 of Cable Panel, sl M, k3.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Row 6 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p to end - 29(29, 30, 30) sts.

Now rep from **, but working correct row of Cable Panel, 3(4, 5, 5) times more - 41(45, 50, 50) sts on the needle, with 18(22, 27, 27) sts on left side of cable panel.

Size 44-46 only:

Next Row: K to marker, incl, sl M, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, k3 - 51 sts.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p to end.

Next Row: K to marker, incl, sl M, work Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, k3 - 52 sts.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, p to end.

Next Row: K2, incl, k to marker, incl, sl M, work Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, k3 - 54 sts.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, p to end.

Sizes 32-34 and 36-38 only:

*****Next Row:** K to marker, sl M, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, k3.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, W&T.

Short Row: Sl M, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, k3.

Next Row: P3, sl M, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, p to end.

Repeat from *** 5(2) times more.

All Sizes: Keeping pattern correct and omitting short rows, work even until piece measures 11(11.5, 12, 12.5)" [28(29, 30.5, 31.5) cm] from bottom edge (outside edge of cast on or bottom tip of piece), ending after a wrong side row.

To Shape Front Neck:

Next Row: (right side) K to 2 sts before first marker, k2tog, sl M, work in pattern to end.

Work 5 rows even in pattern.

Continue to dec one st as set on every following 6th row 8(8, 10, 10) times AND AT THE SAME TIME, beg armhole once piece measures 14.5" [37 cm] from bottom edge, ending after a wrong side row.

To Shape Armhole:

Next Row: (right side) Cast off 4(5, 6, 7) sts, work in pattern to end, dec for front neck as required.

Now keeping front neck shaping correct as set, dec one st at beg of every alternate row following 3(4, 5, 7) times.

Now continue in pattern, dec for front neck until 25(27, 28, 29) sts rem.

Work even in pattern until armhole measures 7.5(8, 8.5, 9)" [19(20.5, 21.5, 23) cm], ending after a wrong side row.

Next Row: K2(4, 5, 6), p2, [k2tog] 8 times, p2, k3.

Cast off in pattern.

Right Front: Using larger needles, cast on 21(21, 22, 22) sts.

Next Row: K3, PM, p2, k 12, p2, PM, k2(2, 3, 3).

Next Row: P2(2, 3, 3), sl M, k2, p4, [inc one st in next st purlwise] 4 times, p4, k2, sl M, p3 - 25(25, 26, 26) sts.

****Next Row:** K3, sl M, work Row 1 of Cable Panel to marker, sl M, W&T.

Short Row: Sl M, work Row 2 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p3.

Next Row: K3, sl M, work Row 3 of Cable Panel, sl M, k1, incl, k1(1, 2, 2) - 26(26, 27, 27) sts.

Next Row: P to marker, sl M, work Row 4 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p to end.

Next Row: K3, sl M, work Row 5 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, W&T.

Short Row: Sl M, work Row 6 of Cable Panel, sl M, p3.

Next Row: K3, sl M, work Row 1 of Cable Panel, sl M, k1, incl, k to end - 27(27, 28, 28) sts.

Next Row: P to marker, sl M, work Row 2 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p3.

Next Row: K3, sl M, work Row 3 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, W&T.

Short Row: Sl M, work Row 4 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p3.

Next Row: K3, sl M, work Row 5 of Cable Panel to marker, sl M, k1, incl, k to last 2 sts, incl, k2 - 29(29, 30, 30) sts.

Next Row: P to marker, sl M, work Row 6 of Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p3.

Now rep from **, but working correct row of Cable Panel, 3(4, 5, 5) times more - 41(45, 50, 50) sts on the needle, with 18(22, 27, 27) sts on left side of cable panel.

Size 44-46 only:

Next Row: K3, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, k1, incl, k to end - 51 sts.

Next Row: P to marker, sl M, work Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p3.

Next Row: K3, sl M, work Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, k1, incl, k to end - 52 sts.

Next Row: P to marker, sl M, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, p3.

Next Row: K3, sl M, work Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, k1, incl, k to last 2 sts, incl, k2 - 54 sts.

Next Row: P to marker, sl M, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, p3.

Sizes 32-34 and 36-38 only:

*****Next Row:** K3, sl M, work Cable Panel to marker, sl M, W&T.

Short Row: Sl M, work Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p3.

Next Row: K3, sl M, work Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, k to end.

Next Row: P to marker, sl M, work Cable Panel to next marker, sl M, p3.

Repeat from *** 5(2) times more.

All Sizes: Keeping pattern correct and omitting short rows, work even until piece measures 11(11.5, 12, 12.5)" [28(29, 30.5, 31.5) cm] from bottom edge (outside edge of cast on or bottom tip of piece), ending after a wrong side row.

To Shape Front Neck:

Next Row: (right side) Work in pattern to 2nd marker, sl M, sl 1, k1, pssso, work in pattern to end.

Work 5 rows even in pattern.

Continue to dec one st as set on every following 6th row 8(8, 10, 10) times AND AT THE SAME TIME, beg armhole once piece measures 14.5" [37 cm] from bottom edge, ending after a right side row.

To Shape Armhole:

Next Row: (wrong side) Cast off 4(5, 6, 7) sts, work in pattern to end.

Now keeping front neck shaping correct as set, dec one st at beg of every alternate row following 3(4, 5, 7) times.

Now continue in pattern, dec for front neck until 25(27, 28, 29) sts rem.

Work even in pattern until armhole measures 7.5(8, 8.5, 9)" [19(20.5, 21.5, 23) cm], ending after a wrong side row.

Next Row: K3, p2, [k2tog] 8 times, p2, k2(4, 5, 6).

Cast off in pattern.

Sew both shoulder seams.

Front Bands and Collar: Using circular needle and with right side facing, beg at cast on edge of right front, pick up and k one st for every row up right front to shoulder seam, k sts from back neck st holder, dec as required in order to have an odd number of sts on needle (take number of sts from right front x 2, then add back neck sts), pick up and k same number of sts down left front edge, from shoulder seam to cast off edge.

Row 1: (wrong side) P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 2: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end. Repeat these 2 rows 6 times more, then Row 1 once.

Now work in short rows as follows:

Next Row: (right side) Work in ribbing up right front and across back neck, ending with a k st, W&T.

Short Row: Work in ribbing across to other side of back neck, ending with a k st, W&T.

Short Row: Work in ribbing across to previous wrapped st, then work in ribbing over next 10 sts (including wrapped st), W&T.

Short Row: Work in ribbing back across to previous wrapped st, then work in ribbing over next 10 sts (including wrapped st), W&T.

Repeat these last 2 Short Rows 4 times more.

Work in ribbing to end of row.

Next Row: Work in ribbing over all sts. Cast off loosely in ribbing.

To Complete: Fold sleeves in half lengthwise and pin a fold to each shoulder seam. Sew sleeves in place, easing to fit armholes.

Sew side and sleeve seams, being sure to match ribbing at bottom edges (cast on edge of each front becomes part of the side seam).
