

SHOPPING LIST

Yarn (DK/Sport Weight)



Mary Maxim Prism

[3.5 ounces, 290 yards

(100 grams, 265 meters) per ball]:

- Blue Lagoon (MC) 3 balls
- Fall Harvest (CC) 3 balls

Knitting Needle

24" [60 cm] Circular Needle

- Size 8 (5.0 mm)

or size needed for gauge



SIZE INFORMATION

Sizes: XSm/Med, Lge/2XL

To Fit Bust: 28-38"(40-50")

Finished Rectangle:

18(22)" [46 (56) cm] wide x 32(36)"

[81.5(91.5)cm] long

GAUGE INFORMATION

26 sts and 24 rows to 4" [10 cm]

measured over pattern using

suggested needle or any size

needle which will give the correct

stitch gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

- k** knit
- p** purl
- sl** slip
- st(s)** stitch(es)
- beg** begin or beginning
- cm** centimeters
- mm** millimeter

- rem** remain or remaining
- rep** repeat
- tog** together
- yo** yarn over
- psso** pass slip stitch over
- kfb** Knit into front and back of next st (increase one st)
- MC** main color
- CC** contrast color

Notes:

The poncho is two rectangles worked separately and then sewn together. The rectangles are knit in rows, however using a circular needle as suggested makes it easier to see the pattern as it is knit. Carry color not currently being used along side edge.

INSTRUCTIONS

Rectangle: (make 2)

Using MC, cast on 116(129) sts.

Do not join but work back and forth in rows as follows.

Knit 2 rows.

Now work in pattern as follows:

Row 1: (right side) Using MC, k6, *kfb, k4, sl 1 purlwise, k2tog, pss0 = **SK2P**, k4, kfb; rep from * 7(8) times more, k6.

Row 2: K6, p to last 6 sts, k6.

Rows 3-8: Repeat Rows 1 and 2 three times.

Rows 9 and 10: Using CC, rep Rows 1 and 2.

Rows 11-14: Using MC, rep Rows 1 and 2 twice.

Rows 15 and 16: Using CC, rep Rows 1 and 2.

Rows 17 and 18: Using MC, rep Rows 1 and 2.

Rows 19-26: Using CC, rep Rows 1 and 2 four times.

Rows 27 and 28: Using MC, rep Rows 1 and 2.

Rows 29-32: Using CC, rep Rows 1 and 2 twice.

Rows 33 and 34: Using MC, rep Rows 1 and 2.

Rows 35 and 36: Using CC, repeat Rows 1 and 2.

Repeat these 36 rows for color pattern until Rectangle measures about 32(36)" [81.5(91.5) cm] from cast on edge, ending after a Row 8 or Row 26. Using same color as last 8 rows, knit 2 rows.

Cast off loosely knitwise.

Begin by blocking rectangles as follows:

Lay Rectangles out flat and pin to correct measurements, with cast on edges at bottom. Cover with a fairly damp towel and apply pressure to transfer moisture through to Rectangles.

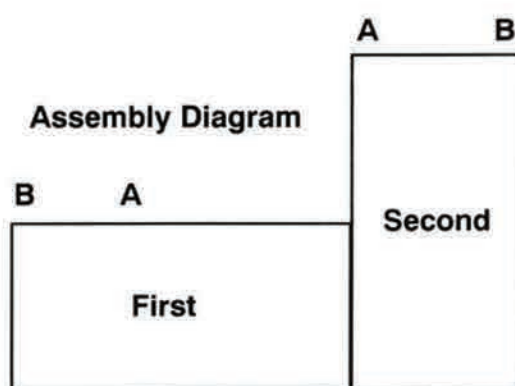
Leave until towel is dry.

To Complete:

Sew cast off edge of First Rectangle to side of Second Rectangle (see diagram below) as desired.

Now fold cast off edge of Second Rectangle around to side of First Rectangle (matching B to B and A to A as shown in diagram) and sew seam.

Weave in all ends.
