Materials:

Mary Maxim Babys Best DK /sport weight yarn: **4 balls**
Button

Suggested Needles:

Size 3-6 months use Size 5 US, (Canadian size 9, Metric size 3.75 mm)

Size 9-12 months use Size 6 US, (Canadian size 8, Metric size 4.00 mm)

Measurements:

Finished Chest Measurement: 18½(21½)" [47(54.5) cm]

Length from Back Neck: 11" [28 cm] for both

Sleeve Length: 4¼(4¾)" [10.5(12) cm]

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

Gauge: Size 3-6 months: 20 sts (2 repeats) to 3" [7.5 cm] and 28 rows to 4" [10 cm] using smaller needles

Size 9-12 months: 20 sts (2 repeats) to 3½" [9 cm] and 28 rows to 4" [10 cm] using larger needles, both measured over pattern using **suggested** needles or any size needles which will give the correct stitch gauge or tension.

Carefully follow washing and drying instructions printed on yarn label for finished items.

Abbreviations: K, knit; p, purl; st, stitch; sts, stitches; St st, Stocking stitch; beg, begin or beginning; dec, decrease or decreasing; inc, increase or increasing; ", inches; cm, centimeters; mm, millimeter; rem, remain or remaining; rep, repeat; sl, slip; tbl, through back loop; tog, together; yo, yarn over; yrn, yarn round needle; PM, place marker; M, marker.

Note: Needles sizes are not referred to within the pattern, so please take note that Size 3-6 months use smaller size needles listed for all pieces, and Size 9-12 months use larger size needles listed for all pieces or which ever size gives you the correct gauge as given for size being worked.

Lace Pattern:

Row 1: P3, k5, k2tog, yrn.

Row 2: K3, yrn, p1, p2tog, p4.

Row 3: P3, k3, k2tog, k2, yrn.

Row 4: K3, yrn, p3, p2tog, p2.

Row 5: P3, k1, k2tog, k4, yrn.

Row 6: K3, yrn, p5, p2tog.

Row 7: P3, yo, k2tog, k5.

Row 8: K3, p4, p2tog, p1, yo.

Row 9: P3, yo, k2, k2tog, k3.

Row 10: K3, p2, p2tog, p3, yo.

Row 11: P3, yo, k4, k2tog, k1.

Row 12: K3, p2tog, p5, yo.

Repeat these 12 rows for Lace Pattern.

Sweater: Worked in one piece to armholes.

Cast on 137 sts and work folded hem as follows:

****Work 4 rows in St st - one row k, one row p.**

Next Row: (eyelet row) K1, *yo, k2tog; rep from * to end.

Now beg with a p row, work 4 rows of St st.

Now fold piece in half and join as follows:

Using a spare needle 2 or 3 sizes smaller than size being used, pick up 137 sts along cast on edge, being sure to end with point of spare needle facing in same direction as working needle.

Now with right side facing, fold work along eyelet row to back, bringing spare needle up behind the working needle.

Next Row: (right side) *Taking one st from front needle and one st from back needle, k2tog; rep from * to end** - 137 sts.

Next Row: *K 12, inc one st in next st knitwise; rep from * to last 7 sts, k7 - 147 sts.

Begin Pattern:

Row 1: (right side) K1, [p1, k1] 3 times (front band), PM, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern 3 times, p3, PM, k2, (these 2 sts will divide the back from front), PM, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern 6 times, p3, PM, k2, (these 2 sts will divide back from front), PM, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern 3 times, p3, PM, k1, [p1, k1] 3 times (front band) - 147 sts.

Row 2: P1, [k1, p1] 3 times, sl M, work Row 2 of Lace Pattern 3 times, k3, sl M, p2, sl M,

work Row 2 of Lace Pattern 6 times, k3, sl M, p2, sl M,

work Row 2 of Lace Pattern 3 times, k3, sl M, p1, [k1, p1] 3 times.

Row 3: K1, [p1, k1] 3 times, sl M, work Row 3 of Lace Pattern 3 times, p3,

sl M, k2, sl M,

work Row 3 of Lace Pattern 6 times, p3, sl M, k2, sl M,

work Row 3 of Lace Pattern 3 times, p3, sl M, k1 [p1, k1] 3 times.

Row 4: P1, [k1, p1] 3 times, sl M, work Row 4 of Lace Pattern 3 times, k3,

sl M, p2, sl M,

work Row 4 of Lace Pattern 6 times, k3, sl M, p2, sl M,

work Row 4 of Lace Pattern 3 times, k3, sl M, p1 [k1, p1] 3 times.

Now keeping first 7 sts and last 7 sts (front bands) in ribbing and 2 sts between the markers on each side in St st as set, continue working correct rows of Lace Pattern until 30 rows have been completed, thus finishing with Row 6 of the third repeat of Lace Pattern.

Piece should measure about 5" [12.5 cm] from folded edge.

Right Front:

Next Row: (right side) Work ribbing to M, sl M, work Row 7 of Lace Pattern 3 times, p3, sl M, inc one st in next st knitwise, turn - 42 sts.

Place rem sts onto a spare needle and continue working back and forth on these 42 sts only.

Next Row: P1, inc one st in next st purlwise, sl M, work Row 8 of Lace Pattern 3 times, k3, sl M, work ribbing to end - 43 sts.

Next Row: Work ribbing to first M, sl M, work Row 9 of Lace Pattern 3 times, p3, sl M, k1, inc one st in next st knitwise, k1 - 44 sts.

Next Row: P1, inc one st in next st purlwise, p2, sl M, work Row 10 of Lace Pattern 3 times, k3, sl M, work ribbing to end - 45 sts.

Next Row: Work ribbing to first M, sl M, work Row 11 of Lace Pattern 3 times, p3, sl M, k3, inc one st in next st knitwise, k1 - 46 sts.

Next Row: Using 2 needle cast on method (see illustrations), cast on 24 sts for sleeve; now work Row 12 of Lace Pattern 6 times, k3, sl M, work ribbing to end - 70 sts.

Next Row: Work ribbing to first M, sl M, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern 6 times, p3. Now continue, keeping patterns correct until 18 rows of Lace Pattern have been completed from cast on of Sleeve, thus finishing after Row 6 of the second repeat.

Piece should measure about 8½" [21.5 cm] from bottom edge (fold) at this point.

To Shape Neck:

Next Row: (right side) Work in pattern over first 10 sts, then place these sts onto st holder for neckband, work in pattern to end - 60 sts.

Next Row: Work in pattern to last 2 sts, p2tog tbl.

Next Row: K2tog tbl, work in pattern to end.

Next Row: Cast off 10 sts, work in pattern to last 2 sts, p2tog tbl - 47 sts.

Next Row: K2tog tbl, work in pattern to end - 46 sts. Repeat these last 2 rows until 10 sts rem. Cast off all sts.

Back: With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts.

Next Row: (right side) Inc one st in first st knitwise, sl M, work Row 7 of Lace Pattern 6 times, p3, sl M, inc one st in next st knitwise - 67 sts.

Leave rem sts on spare needle and work only on these sts for Back.

Next Row: P1, inc one st in next st purlwise, sl M, work Row 8 of Lace Pattern 6 times, k3, sl M, inc one st in next st purlwise, p1 - 69 sts.

Next Row: K1, inc in next st, k1, sl M, work Row 9 of Lace Pattern 6 times, p3, sl M, k1, inc one st in next st knitwise, k1 - 71 sts.

Next Row: P1, inc one st in next st purlwise, p2, sl M, work Row 10 of Lace Pattern 6 times, k3, sl M, p2, inc one st in next st purlwise, p1 - 73 sts.

Next Row: K1, inc one st in next st knitwise, k3, sl M, work Row 11 of Lace Pattern 6 times, p3, sl M, k1, inc one st in next st knitwise, k3 - 75 sts.

Row 12: Cast on 24 sts for left sleeve as before; now work Row 12 of Lace Pattern 9 times removing marker, k3, remove marker, p6 - 99 sts.

Next Row: Cast on 24 sts for right sleeve as before; work Row 1 of Lace Pattern 12 times, p3 - 123 sts.

Next Row: Work Row 2 of Lace Pattern 12 times, k3. Now work even in Lace Pattern until Row 12 of the 4th repeat (from beg of sweater), has been completed.

Now cast off 10 sts at beg of every row 10 times.

Place rem 23 sts onto st holder for neckband.

Left Front:

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem 41 sts.

Next Row: Inc one st in first st knitwise, sl M,

work Row 7 of Lace Pattern 3 times, p3, sl M, work ribbing as set to end - 42 sts.

Next Row: Work ribbing to first M, sl M, work Row 8 of Lace Pattern 3 times, k3, sl M, inc one st in next st purlwise, p1 - 43 sts.

Next Row: K1, inc one st in next st knitwise, k1, sl M, work Row 9 of Lace pattern 3 times, p3, sl M, work ribbing to end - 44 sts.

Next Row: Work ribbing to first M, sl M, work Row 10 of Lace Pattern 3 times, k3, sl M, p1, inc one st in next st purlwise, p2 - 45 sts.

Next Row: K1, inc in next st knitwise, k3, sl M, work Row 11 of Lace Pattern 3 times, p3, sl M, work ribbing to end - 46 sts.

Next Row: Work ribbing to first M, sl M, work Row 12 of Lace Pattern 3 times, k3, sl M, k6.

Next Row: Cast on 24 sts for sleeve; now work Row 1 of Lace Pattern 6 times, p3, sl M, work ribbing to end - 70 sts.

Now continue, keeping patterns correct until 17 rows of Lace Pattern have been completed from cast on of Sleeves, thus finishing after a Row 5 of the second repeat.

Piece should measure about 8½" [21.5 cm] from bottom edge (fold) at this point.

To Shape Neck:

Next Row: Work in pattern over first 10 sts, then slip these sts onto st holder for neckband, work in pattern to end - 60 sts.

Next Row: Work in pattern to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Next Row: P2tog, work in pattern to end.

Next Row: Cast off 10 sts, work in pattern to last 2 sts, k2tog - 47 sts.

Next Row: P2tog, work in pattern to end - 46 sts. Repeat these last 2 rows until 10 sts rem. Cast off all sts.

Sew upper seams of both sleeves.

Sleeve Bands: With right side facing, pick up and k 37 sts along end of one sleeve.

Now beg with a p row, work 3 rows in St st.

Next Row: (eyelet row) K1, *yo, k2tog; rep from * to end.

Now beg with a p row, work 3 rows of St st.

Cast off loosely knitwise.

Fold band in half along eyelet row to inside and sew cast on edge along pick up row loosely.

Repeat on other sleeve.

Neckband: With right side facing, beg at right front edge, work sts from st holder as follows: K1, p1, k1, yo, k2tog (buttonhole), p1, [k1, p1] twice, pick up and knit 13 sts to shoulder seam, k sts from back neck st holder, pick up and knit 13 sts down left side of front neck, work sts from left front st holder as follows: [p1, k1] 5 times - 69 sts.

Now work ribbing as follows:

Row 1: P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 2: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Repeat these last 2 rows once more, then Row 1 once. Cast off loosely in rib.

To Complete: Sew lower seams of both sleeves, including bands.

Hat: Cast on 71 sts loosely.

Now work as given for Sweater from ** to **, but picking up 71 sts along cast on edge - 71 sts.

Next Row: Knit, inc one st in center - 72 sts.

Now keeping the first st and last st in St st (k on right side rows, p on wrong side rows), work Rows 1-12 of Lace Pattern over center 70 sts, working repeat 7 times across each row.

Now beg with a k row, work in St st until piece measures 4½" [11.5 cm] from folded edge, ending after a p row.

Next Row: (dec row) K1, [K5, k2tog] 10 times, k1 - 62 sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K1, [K4, k2tog], k1 10 times - 52 sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K1, [K3, k2tog], k1 10 times - 42 sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K1, [K2, k2tog], k1 10 times - 32 sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K1, [K1, k2tog], k1 10 times - 22 sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: [K2tog] 10 times - 11 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread yarn through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely. Using long tail, sew back seam.

Booties: Cast on 35 sts.

Work as given for Sweater from ** to ** - 35 sts.

Row 1: K1, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern 3 times, p3, k1.

Row 2: P1, work Row 2 of Lace Pattern 3 times, k3, p1.

Now keeping first st and last st in St st, continue working until 12 rows of Lace Pattern have been completed. Now work ribbing as follows:

Row 1: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2: P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Repeat these last 2 rows 4 times more, then Row 1 once, dec 2 sts evenly across last row - 33 sts.

Next Row: K 22, turn.

Next Row: P 11, turn.

Work 14 rows St st on these 11 sts only (instep). Break yarn.

Next Row: With right side of work facing, pick up and k 14 sts along right side of instep, k 11 sts of instep, pick up and k 14 sts along left side of instep, k rem 11 sts on needle - 61 sts.

Now beg with a p row, work 5 rows St st.

To Shape Instep:

Row 1: K2tog, k 23, k3tog, k5, k3tog tbl, k 23, k2tog - 55 sts.

Row 2 and every alternate row: Purl.

Row 3: K2tog, k 21, k3tog, k3, k3tog tbl, k 21, k2tog - 49 sts.

Row 5: K2tog, k 19, k3tog, k1, k3tog tbl, k 19, k2tog - 43 sts.

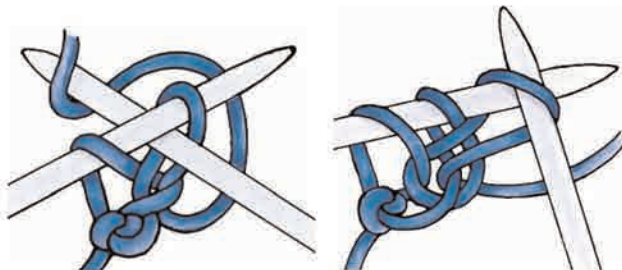
Row 6: Purl.

Cast off knitwise.

Sew back and sole seam. Fold down cuff.

Repeat for other bootie.
