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Materials: Mary Maxim Best Value yarn

| Color 6 | Merlot | 2 skeins |

Suggested Hook:

Size H-8 US, (Canadian size 6, Metric size 5.00 mm)

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

Gauge: One pattern repeat of 17 sts to 5½" [14 cm], using **suggested** hook or any size hook which will give the correct stitch gauge or tension.

Carefully follow washing and drying instructions as printed on yarn label for completed project.

Abbreviations: MC, Main Color; ch, chain; sc, single crochet; hdc, half double crochet; dc, double crochet; tr, treble crochet; sl, slip; st, stitch; sts, stitches; beg, begin or beginning; ", inches; yds, yards; gm, gram; cm, centimeters; mm, millimeter; rep, repeat.

Note: Afghan is worked lengthwise from side to side.

When changing colors, complete last st of old color by drawing new color through last loop of last st.

To Make: Using Color 1, ch 184.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end - 183 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, *sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of next 3 sts, dc in each of next 3 sts, tr in each of next 3 sts, dc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of next 3 sts; rep from * to last 3 sts, sc in each of last 3 sts, changing to MC in last st - 183 sts. Break Color 1 and fasten off.

Row 3: (right side) Using MC, ch 1, turn, **working in back loops only**, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, **working in back loops only**, sc in each sc across, changing to Color 2 in last st. Break MC and fasten off.

Row 5: Using Color 2, ch 4 (counts as 1st tr), turn, tr in each of next 2 sts, dc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of next 3 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of 3 sts, dc in each of next 3 sts, *tr in each of next 3 sts, dc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of next 3 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of next 3 sts, dc in each of next 3 sts; rep from * to last 3 sts, tr in each of last 3 sts.

Rows 6 and 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 8: Work as Row 5, but changing to MC in last

st. Break Color 2 and fasten off.

Rows 9 and 10: Repeat Rows 3 and 4, but changing to Color 3 in last st of Row 10.

Row 11: Using Color 3, work as Row 2, but do not change color at end of row.

Rows 12 and 13: Repeat Rows 6 and 7.

Row 14: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 15 and 16: Repeat Rows 3 and 4, changing to Color 4 in last st of Row 16. Break MC and fasten off.

Row 17: Using Color 4, rep Row 5.

Rows 18 and 19: Repeat Rows 6 and 7.

Row 20: Repeat Row 5, but changing to MC in last st. Break Color 4 and fasten off.

Rows 21 and 22: Repeat Rows 3 and 4, changing to Color 5 in last st of Row 22. Break MC and fasten off.

Row 23: Using Color 5, rep Row 2.

Rows 24 and 25: Repeat Rows 6 and 7.

Row 26: Repeat Row 2. Break Color 5 and fasten off.

Rows 27 and 28: Repeat Rows 3 and 4, changing to Color 6 in last st of Row 28. Break MC and fasten off.

Row 29: Using Color 6, rep Row 5.

Rows 30 and 31: Repeat Rows 6 and 7.

Row 32: Repeat Row 5, but changing to MC in last st. Break Color 6 and fasten off.

Rows 33 and 34: Repeat Rows 3 and 4, changing to Color 1 in last st of Row 34.

Row 35: Using Color 1, rep Row 2 but do not change color at end of row.

Rows 36 and 37: Repeat Rows 6 and 7.

Row 38: Repeat Row 2.

Repeat Rows 3-38 twice, then Rows 3-36 once more. Do Not fasten off.

Border: Ch 1, turn, work in sc around entire outside edge of Throw, making sure to have the same number of sts along each end as well as each side of Throw and work 3 sc into each corner, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, working 3 sc in center sc of each corner, join with sl st in first sc. Break yarn and fasten off.
