Suggested Needles:

Size 3 US, (Canadian size 10, Metric size 3.25 mm)
Size 6 US, (Canadian size 8, Metric size 4.00 mm)

Measurements:

Finished Chest Measurement: 23(25, 27)" [58.5(63.5, 68.5) cm]
Length from Shoulder: 14(15, 16)" [35.5(38m 40.5) cm]
Sleeve Seam: 9(11, 12½)" [23(28, 31.5) cm]

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

Gauge or Tension: 22 sts and 28 rows to 4" [10 cm], measured over Stocking stitch using **suggested** larger needles or any size needles which will give the correct stitch gauge or tension.

Wash in cool water, gentle cycle. Dry using low heat, maximum 5 minutes, remove and lay flat to dry.

Abbreviations: MC, Main Color; CC, Contrast Color; k, knit; p, purl; st, stitch; sts, stitches; beg, begin or beginning; dec, decrease or decreasing; inc, increase or increasing; ", inches; yds, yards; cm, centimeters; mm, millimeter; rem, remain or remaining; rep, repeat; sl, slip; yo, yarn over; tog, together.

Front: **Using smaller needles and CC 1, cast on 63(69, 75) sts and knit 6 rows.

Change to CC 2 and knit 4 rows.**

Change to larger needles and beg with a k row, proceed to follow Graph in St st - one row k, one row p. Work design in "Colored Pattern" knitting method, using separate balls of yarn for each section of the design. Remember always to cross yarns when changing colors to avoid leaving a hole in the knitting.

Cast off and dec for armholes as indicated.

Place center front sts on st holder for neckband and dec for front neck as indicated - 11(12, 14) sts rem for each shoulder.

Cast off each side on last row.

Embroidery: Using CC 2, backstitch outside line on red sail as indicated on graph.

Back: Work as for Front from ** to **.

Change to larger needles and beg with a k row, proceed to follow Graph in St st, but omitting sailboat and front neck shaping.

Follow graph until 68(76, 82) rows have been completed.

Back Opening:

Next Row: (right side) K 21(23, 26), join another ball of MC to rem sts and cast off next 5 sts, k to end.

Now working both sides at the same time, continue even in St st for 17 rows.

Next Row: 1st half - Knit to last 6(7, 8) sts, place rem sts on st holder for neckband.

2nd half - K6(7, 8), place these sts on st holder for neckband, k to end - 15(16, 18) sts on each side.




Now dec one st at each neck edge until 11(12, 14) sts rem on each side.

Work even in St st until piece measures same length as Front to shoulders. Cast off each side.

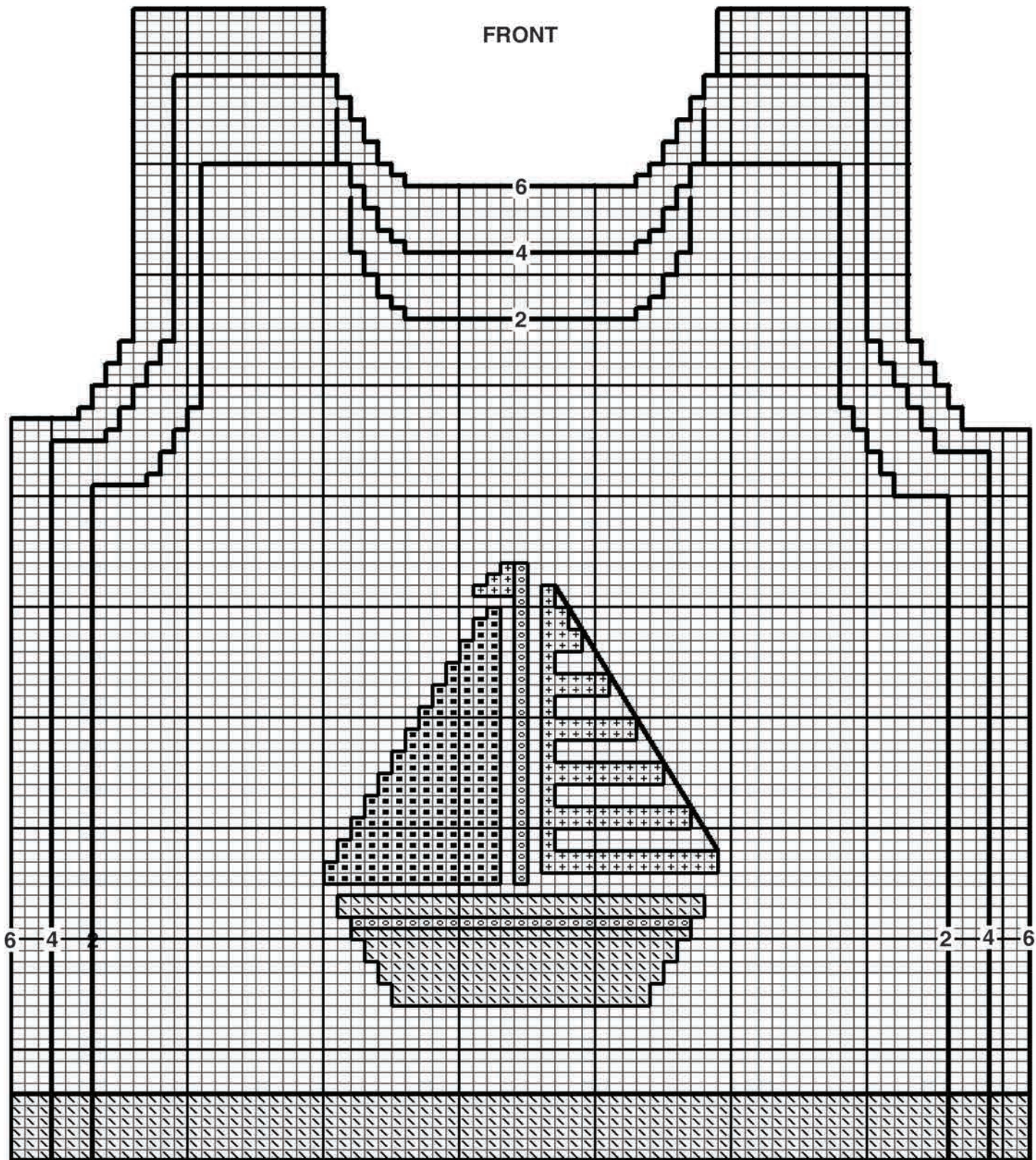
Buttonband: (worked on left half of back for girls, right half of back for boys)

Using smaller needles and with right side facing, pick up and k 13 sts evenly along side edge of back opening. Knit 6 rows. Cast off knitwise.

KNIT FIRM BAND BEFORE STARTING GRAPH

Buttonhole Band: (work on opposite half of back)
Work as given for buttonband until 2 rows have been completed.

Next Row: Buttonhole Row: K5, k2tog, yo, k6.

Knit 3 rows. Cast off knitwise.

Sleeves: Using smaller needles and CC 1, cast on 33(35, 37) sts and work as given for Front from ** to **.

Change to larger needles, beg with a k row and using CC 3, work 6 rows in St st.

Change to MC and continue in St st, inc one st at each end of the next row, then every 6th row 0(1, 1) time, then on every 8th row following until there are 43(45, 47) sts on the needle.

Work even in St st until sleeve measures 9(11, 12½)" [23(28, 31.5) cm] from cast on edge, ending after a p row.

To Shape Cap: Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows - 35(37, 39) sts.

Now dec one st at each end of every alternate row following until 15(15, 7) sts rem.

Now cast off 2(2, 0) sts at beg of next 4 rows - 7(7, 7) sts rem. Cast off rem sts.

Sew both shoulder seams.

Neckband: Using smaller needles and CC 3, with right side facing, beg at left back band, pick up and k 15(16, 17) sts up left side of back neck (including sts on st holder), pick up and k 13 sts down left side of front neck, k sts from front st holder, pick up and k 13 sts up right side of front neck, pick up and k 15(16, 17) sts down right side of back neck (including sts on st holder) - 73(75, 77) sts.

Knit one row.

Next Row:

Buttonhole Row for Boys: K3, yo, k2tog, k to end.

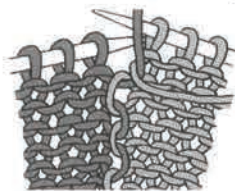
Buttonhole Row for Girls: Knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, yo, k3.

Knit 4 more rows.

Cast off loosely knitwise.

To Complete: Fold sleeves in half lengthwise and pin a fold to each shoulder seam. Sew sleeves in place, easing to fit armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons opposite each buttonhole.

How to Work Design



Colored Pattern Knitting:

This method is used for large areas of each color and background, using small balls of color for each area. Work required number of sts, drop color in use to be picked up on next row, bring new color under and over last color, thus avoiding a hole in the knitting.

NOTE: Instructions are given for the smallest size and remaining sizes are given in the brackets following. Where only one set of instructions are given, this will apply to all sizes. Every square on the graph represents a stitch. Changes in color and texture are shown by different symbols. Follow graph from right to left for knit rows and left to right for purl rows.
