# Suggested Needles:

One pair knitting needles size 8 US, (Canadian size 6, Metric size 5.00 mm) One pair knitting needles size 9 US, (Canadian size 5, Metric size 5.50 mm)

#### TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

Gauge or Tension: 18 sts and 24 rows to 4" [10 cm] measured over Stocking stitch using the suggested smaller needles or any size needles which will give the correct stitch gauge and 20 sts and 24 rows to 4" [10 cm] measured over pattern stitch using suggested larger needles or any size needles which will give the correct stitch gauge.

Wash in cool water, gentle cycle. Dry using low heat, maximum 5 minutes, remove and lay flat to dry.

## Special Abbreviation:

ssk - slip, slip, knit together: Slip next 2 sts knitwise, one at a time to right needle, slip left needle through both sts from back to front and knit 2 together as usual.

Scarf: Using larger needles and MC, cast on 30 sts and work in pattern as follows:

Row 1: (right side) \*K3, p3; rep from \* to end.

Row 2: \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern until piece measures 4" [10 cm] from cast on edge, ending after a

Next Row: Change to CC and knit, dec 4 sts evenly across - 26 sts.

Next Row: K1, p to last st, k1.

Next Row: Knit. Next Row: K1, p to last st, k1.

**Next Row:** Change to MC and knit, inc 4 sts even-

ly across - 30 sts.

Now beg with Row 2 of pattern, work 3 rows even in pattern.

**Next Row:** Change to CC and knit.

Next Row: K1, p to last st, k1. **Next Row:** Change to MC and beg with Row 2 of pattern, work even in pattern until scarf measures

36(48)" [91.5(122) cm] from cast on edge, ending after a Row 2.

Next Row: Change to CC and knit.

Next Row: K1, p to last st, k1.

**Next Row:** Change to MC and knit, inc 4 sts evenly across - 30 sts.

Now beg with Row 2 of pattern, work 3 rows even. **Next Row:** Change to CC and knit.

Now continue in MC only until scarf measures about

Next Row: K1, p to last st, k1. Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: K1, p to last st, k1.

Next Row: Change to MC and knit, inc 4 sts evenly across - 30 sts.

42(54)" [106.5(137) cm] from cast on edge, ending after a Row 1.

Cast off in k1, p1 ribbing. Weave in all ends.

Fringe: Cut 40 strands of each color, each strand being 12" [30.5 cm] in length.

Using 4 strands of one color tog and a crochet hook, knot into fringe evenly spaced along both ends of scarf, alternating colors (use color picture as guide).

Trim ends as desired.

**Hat:** Using smaller needles and MC, cast on 72(84) sts and work band as follows:

Row 1: (right side) \*K3, p3; rep from \* to end.

Row 2: \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern until piece measures 3" [7.5 cm] from cast on edge, ending after a Now beg with a k row, work in St st - one row k, one row p until piece measures 51/2(61/2)" [14(16.5) cm] from top of band, ending after a p row. To Shape Crown: Change to CC and work 4 rows as follows:

Row 1 and dec 0(3) sts evenly across - 72(81) sts.

**Next Row:** K4, k2tog, \*k7, k2tog; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3 - 64(72) sts.

Next Row: Purl. **Next Row:** K3, k2tog, \*k6, k2tog; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3 - 56(63) sts. Next Row: Purl.

Change to MC and work 4 rows as follows:

Next Row: K2, k2tog, \*k5, k2tog; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3 - 48(54) sts. Next Row: Purl. Next Row: K1, k2tog, \*k4, k2tog; rep from \* to last

3 sts, k3 - 40(45) sts. Next Row: Purl.

Change to CC and work 2 rows as follows: **Next Row:** K5, k2tog, \*k3, k2tog; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3 - 33(37) sts. Next Row: Purl. Change to MC and complete as follows:

Next Row: K4, k2tog, \*k2, k2tog; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3 - 26(29) sts. Next Row: Purl. Next Row: K3, k2tog, \*k1, k2tog; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3 - 19(21) sts. Next Row: Purl.

**Next Row:** K1, \*k2tog; rep from \* across - 10(11) sts. Break yarn leaving a long tail for sewing. Thread tail through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely. Using long tail, sew back seam,

taking care to reverse seam on band as it folds back. **Pompom:** Using one strand of both colors, wind

around 4 finges of one hand about 45 times. Cut yarn. Take another piece of CC about 8" [20.5 cm] long and wind this piece around center. Remove fingers, draw up the CC piece tightly, fasten off securely. Cut loops on both sides of center. Trim ends to form pompom as desired. Using ends of CC, sew pom-

pom to top of hat firmly. Mitts: (make 2) Right Mitt: \*\*Using smaller needles and MC, cast on 30(36) sts and work in pattern as follow:

**Row 1:** (right side) \*K3, p3; rep from \* to end. **Row 2:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end. Repeat these 2 rows for pattern until piece measures 3" [7.5 cm] from cast on edge, ending after a

**Next Row:** (wrong side) Purl, dec 2(4) sts evenly

across - 28(32) sts.

next 2 sts, k to end - 30(34) sts. Row 2 and every alternate row following: Purl. **Row 3:** K 15(17), inc one st in next st, k2, inc one st in next st, k to end - 32(36) sts. **Row 5:** K 15(17), inc one st in next st, k4, inc one st in next st, k to end - 34(38) sts.

Row 1: (right side) K 15(17), inc one st in each of

**Row 7:** K 15(17), inc one st in next st, k6, inc one st

in next st, k to end - 36(40) sts. Size 8-12 years only: Row 8: Purl. Row 9: K 17, inc one st in next st, k8, inc one st in next st, k to end - 42 sts.

Thumb Gusset:

All Sizes:

Next Row: Purl. Next Row: K 25(29), turn, leaving rem 11(13) sts unworked. Thumb: P 10(12), turn, cast on 2 sts - 12(14) sts.

Leave rem 15(17) sts unworked. Working on these 12(14) sts only, work in St st until Thumb measures 1(1½)" [2.5(4) cm] from cast on, ending after a p row. **Next Row:** [K1, k2tog] 4 times, k 0(2) - 8(10) sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Change to CC and work 2 rows in St st.

Thread tail through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely. Sew Thumb seam. With right side facing, join yarn to 11(13) sts on left needle and k to end.

**Next Row:** P 11(13), pick up and p2 sts at base of Thumb, p 15(17) - 28(32) sts. Now beg with a k row, work 4(8) rows in St st. Change to CC and work 4 rows in St st. Change to MC and work 4 rows in St st.

To Shape Top: Change to MC and shape top of mitt as follows: **Next Row:** (right side) [K1, ssk, k8(10), k2tog, k1] twice - 24(28) sts. Next Row: Purl.

**Next Row:** [K1, ssk, k6(8), k2tog, k1] twice - 20(24) Next Row: Purl. **Next Row:** [K1, ssk, k4(6), k2tog, k1] twice - 16(20)

Next Row: Purl. **Next Row:** [K1, ssk, k2(4), k2tog, k1] twice - 12(16) Next Row: Purl.

**Next Row:** [K1, k2tog] 4(5) times, k 0(1) - 8(11) sts. Break yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through rem sts, draw up tightly and fas-

ten off securely. Sew side seam of mitt. **Left Mitt:** Work as given for Right Mitt from \*\* to \*\*.

### Thumb Gusset:

Printed in USA

**Row 1:** (right side) K 11(13), inc one st in each of next 2 sts, k to end - 30(34) sts.

Row 2 and every alternate row following: Purl.

Row 3: K 11(13), inc one st in next st, k2, inc one st in next st, k to end - 32(36) sts. Row 5: K 11(13), inc one st in next st, k4, inc one st

in next st, k to end - 34(38) sts.

Row 7: K 11(13), inc one st in next st, k6, inc one st

in next st, k to end - 36(40) sts.

Size 8-12 years only:

Row 8: Purl.

Row 9: K 13, inc one st in next st, k8, inc one st in

next st, k to end - 42 sts. All Sizes:

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K 21(25), turn, leaving rem 15(17) sts

unworked. **Thumb:** P 10(12), turn, cast on 2 sts - 12(14) sts. Leave rem 11(13) sts unworked.

Working on these 12(14) sts only, work in St st until Thumb measures 1(1½)" [2.5(4) cm] from cast on,

ending after a p row. **Next Row:** [K1, k2tog] 4 times, k 0(2) - 8(10) sts. Break yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Thread tail through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely. Sew Thumb seam.

With right side facing, join yarn to 15(17) sts on left needle and k to end. Next Row: P 15(17), pick up and p2 sts at base of

Thumb, p 13(15) - 28(32) sts.

Now beg with a k row, work 4(8) rows in St st. Change to CC and work 4 rows in St st.

Change to MC and work 4 rows in St st. Change to CC and work 2 rows in St st.

To Shape Top:

Change to MC and shape top of mitt as follows: Next Row: (right side) [K1, ssk, k8(10), k2tog, k1]

twice - 24(28) sts. Next Row: Purl.

**Next Row:** [K1, ssk, k6(8), k2tog, k1] twice - 20(24)

sts. Next Row: Purl.

**Next Row:** [K1, ssk, k4(6), k2tog, k1] twice - 16(20) sts.

Next Row: Purl.

**Next Row:** [K1, ssk, k2(4), k2tog, k1] twice - 12(16)

sts. Next Row: Purl.

**Next Row:** [K1, k2tog] 4(5) times, k 0(1) - 8(11) sts. Break yarn, leaving a long tail.

Thread tail through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely. Sew side seam of mitt.
