AUSTRALIAN MAP SHAPED \$1'S



Struck from 1oz of 99.9% pure silver these Australian continent shaped coin portray coloured depictions of Australian Native Wildlife. Each coin has a one dollar denomination and is struck by The Perth Mint.

This coin is the first in the Australian Map Shaped series. The issue depicts a kookaburra, resting on a fence, against the background of a bush scene.

This coin is the second in the Australian Map Shaped series. The coin's coloured reverse depicts an emu against the background of a bush scene with grass trees.

One of the most symbolic animals of Australia, the world-renowned kangaroo is well adapted to hop great distances in a land that offers scarce food and water. The fourth coin in the series depicts a kangaroo against a sunset scene at Picnic Rocks, Tasmania.

The iconic platypus is a semi-aquatic mammal endemic to eastern Australia. With its duck-bill, beaver-tail and otter-like feet, the platypus' unusual appearance baffled naturalists when they first encountered it. This coin is the fourth in the series and depicts a platypus set against a tropical rainforest setting with a waterfall and river.

GREAT SOUTHERN LAND



This beautiful coin features the great southern Australian continent in stunning Australian opal. Australia is the planet's sixth largest country yet the smallest of the world's continents. Evolving across more than 3,000 million years, it is also unique as the lowest, flattest and driest continent (after Antarctica) and home to a diverse range of climates, landscapes and animals.

The 99.99% pure silver 1oz reverse features a central opal insert in the shape of the Australian continent. The outer rim of the \$1 depicts representations of iconic land animals including the kangaroo, emu, koala, echidna, wombat, bilby, Tasmanian devil, frilled-neck lizard, goanna and the eastern brown snake.

WORLD EXPO MAP SHAPED



Australia's first 'Map of Australia' coin was struck for the Shanghai World Expo, 2010.

Made in the shape of the Australian continent, the reverse design portrays a coloured representation of Peng Peng, the Australian pavilion's kookaburra mascot, the Chinese characters for 'Australia' and the Australian pavilion's colourful logo - a representation of the Australian continent in three wavy lines symbolising the blue sea and sky, the red centre and the golden beaches.

80TH ANN. BATTLE OF BRITAIN



The Battle of Britain took place over southern England and the English Channel between July and October 1940. Pitting Britain's Royal Air Force (RAF) against the German Luftwaffe, it was the first major campaign of the Second World War to be fought entirely by air forces.

Struck by The Perth Mint from 1/4oz of 99.99% pure gold in proof quality, the \$25 coin has a mintage of just 500 pieces.

BATTLE OF THE CORAL SEA



Struck by The Perth Mint for the Cook Islands, this 2002 10oz silver proof coloured \$10 coin pays tribute to the lives lost and the gains made during the landmark effort by the combined forces of Australia and the USA during the Battle of the Coral Sea. This 60th anniversary commemorative coin has a small mintage of just 1295 pieces.

To commemorate the 50th anniversary of the Battles of Coral & Balmoral, the Royal Australian Mint struck a 2018 cupro-nickel 50 cent featuring a depiction of two soldiers manning a M2A2 Howitzer, along with a Centurion tank and Iroquois helicopter.

INDUSTRY IN MOTION

This Industry in Motion two-coin set celebrates the evolution of industry and machinery. Struck by The Perth Mint from 1oz of 99.99% pure silver, each innovative gear-shaped \$1 is issued as legal tender of Tuvalu.



The cogwheel, also known as a cog or gear, was a device fundamental to the development of machinery. The rotating machine part with cut teeth is considered one of the oldest pieces of equipment known to man, dating back to before the ancient Greeks. It was first referenced by mathematicians and engineers including Aristotle as early as the 4th century BCE.

The cog was one of several mechanical components that truly came into their own during the Industrial Revolution.

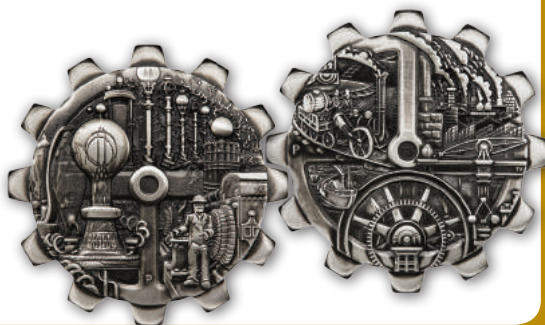
In 1835 the English inventor Joseph Whitworth patented the first gear 'hobbing' process to cut spiral gears. Synonymous in the modern world with engineering, progression and history, the gear has become an icon of industry.



The reverse of each gear-shaped coin depicts several toothed cogs ascending in size from the centre of the coin.

KING EDWARD VII 1902-1910

Edward VII was the King of United Kingdom from 22 January 1901 until his death in 1910. During his reign, a total of 27 types of Australian gold sovereigns were struck at the Sydney, Melbourne and Perth mints.

Each coin features the classic Benedetto Pistrucci design of St. George slaying a dragon with sword. The obverse has a bare head portrait of King Edward VII facing right, designed by George William De Saules.

HIGH RELIEF GOLD SOVEREIGN



The first overseas branch of Britain's Royal Mint was opened in Sydney, NSW in 1855. Enjoying a privilege historically reserved for the mother mint in London, it was empowered to turn gold into official coins called sovereigns.

To celebrate the 165th anniversary of Australia's first sovereign, The Perth Mint has struck an Australian Gold Proof Sovereign in high relief.

This coin pays tribute to Wyon's historic reverse design. With the name of the mint suitably amended, the modern issue also includes a small numeric privy mark denoting that 2020 is the 165th anniversary of Australia's first sovereign.

WEDGE-TAILED EAGLE 5oz SILVER



Depicting master engraver John M. Mercanti's fifth Australian Wedge-tailed Eagle design for The Perth Mint, this exceptionally detailed 5oz silver coin showcases an appreciably raised relief for stunning clarity.

The Australian Wedge-tailed Eagle 2020 5oz Silver Proof Incused High Relief Coin is struck by The Perth Mint from 99.99% pure silver. No more than 1,000 of these \$8 coins will be released worldwide.

The coin's reverse depicts a magnificent wedge-tailed eagle swooping on its prey in the midst of a hunt.

NEW ZEALAND 1935 WAITANGI 6 COIN PROOF SET



The 1935 Waitangi Crown was struck after the New Zealand Numismatic Society approached the government to suggest the issue of a coin commemorating the 1840 signing of the Treaty of Waitangi, New Zealand's founding document.

Mintage was limited to 364 sets of which 97 were presented in an official red case and 267 on a red card.

The crown's reverse, designed by New Zealand artist James Berry and adapted by British artist Percy Metcalfe, shows Ngapuhi Chief Tamati Waka Nene and the first governor of New Zealand, William Hobson, shaking hands above the legend 'Waitangi'.

This lightly toned, six coin proof set consists of a threepence, sixpence, shilling, florin, half crown, crown and is accompanied by an official red case.

2020 FINE SILVER PROOF SET

In 2019 the Royal Australian Mint introduced an historic sixth effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II on Australia's coins. This set of six fine silver proof coins features the new effigy on the obverse, an ideal addition to the collection of any coin enthusiast.



The new effigy dated 2020, which is the sixth to feature on Australian coins since 1953, is adapted from a design by United Kingdom Royal Mint engraver, Jody Clark.

Presented in a beautiful presentation case, accompanied by a numbered Certificate of Authenticity, just 1000 sets will be issued.

2019 was the 50th anniversary of the historic Apollo 11 mission, when astronauts Neil Armstrong, 'Buzz' Aldrin and Michael Collins flew to the Moon, and Armstrong and Aldrin became the first humans to walk on the Moon's surface.

To commemorate this historic event, **for the first time** the Royal Australian Mint released the annual six coin uncirculated and proof year sets with specially designed 5 cent and 1 dollar coins.

The 5 cent features the Apollo 11 Moon landing site and the 1 dollar depicts a representation of the Honeysuckle Creek Tracking Station.

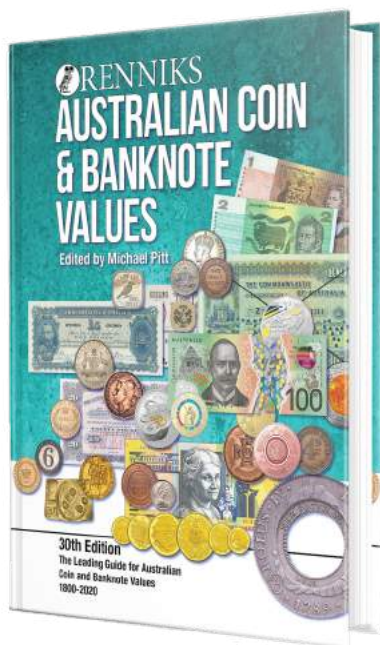
