## GILT DRAGON SHIPWRECK



Wrecked of the coast of Western Australia on 28th April 1656 - the Vergulde Draeck or the Gilt Dragon layed untouched and undiscovered for over 300 years! As part of the Dutch East India Company (V.O.C) fleet, the Vergulde Draeck set sail from Holland on her second voyage to Batavia (modern day Jakarta) in the East Indies.

75 survivors made it to shore and a small contingent set sail to Batavia, but three searches failed to discover the wreck or survivors.

When the Gilt Dragon sank, it was carrying wooden chests filled with Spanish silver coins intended to be used for trade purposes. Spanish American coinage are uniform in weight and purity and those silver coins were hand struck on crudely cut blanks.

A total of 4288 coins have been certified and authenticated by the Western Australian Museum and are now held in institutions or private hands. Only 1508 of them are eight reales or "piece of eight" from the Mexico City Mint.

## HAWAII 1883 SILVER DOLLAR



Kalakaua, was born 16th November 1836 in Honolulu on the island of O'ahu, Hawaii. As the last King of the Hawaiian Islands, Kalakaua was known for his cheerful and friendly personality who enjoyed entertaining guests with his singing and ukulele playing. This charisma meant that he was often referred to as 'The Merrie Monarch'.

As popular tourist attractions still to this day, Kalakaua was responsible for rebuilding of 'Iolani Palace and the statue of Kamehameha I.

Only five official denominations were issued for the Kingdom of Hawaii, designed by Chief Engraver Charles E. Barber and struck by the San Francisco Mint.
