The FIFA World Cup is an international association football competition contested by the senior national teams of the members of Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA), the sport's global governing body.



GEORGE III GOLD GUINEAS

The long reign of King George III (1760-1820) was a period of great change in Britain and its colonies with many conflicts including the Seven Years' War, and the American Revolutionary War which saw the loss of Britain's colonies in North America. The most prominent gold coin of the time, The Guinea - the foundation of Britain's economic growth since 1663, continued its journey as the most trusted gold coin at home and overseas, until in 1817 it was replaced by the Sovereign.

As a special tribute to commemorate the 200th Anniversary of the death of King George III, the 2020 Guinea collection features designs inspired by the most beautiful of King George III's Guineas.

Struck by The East India Company London for the Government of St Helena, each gold proof Guinea is minted to he exact same specifications as its last struck circulating predecessor.

AUSTRALIA 1922/1 OVERDATE THREEPENCE

The 1922/1 overdate threepence is highly sought by collectors. Most examples found are in lower grades of preservation, only three are known in EF or better condition. Estimates of the number remaining in existence range from 200 to 900. The real number is probably at the lower end of that range, around 300 to 350. Even if the higher estimates are accurate, the coin is scarcer than the 1930 penny.
