## TRIAL 1921 SQUARE PENNY



With only a few hundred struck, possibly as few as 100-200 pieces, the Kookaburra Pattern series forms one of Australia's great numismatic rarities.

The square trials resulted from an initiative to find a lighter and more durable alternative to the bulky copper circulation pennies and halfpennies. Thirteen different copper-nickel types dated 1919-1921 were struck and distributed to government officials, VIP's and dignitaries for assessment.

While the distinctive square coins met with some approval, opposition from vending machine operators, the high cost of importing nickel, difficulties striking and the resignation of treasurer William Watt saw the project shelved.

Struck by the Melbourne Mint, this Renniks type 12 Kookaburra Penny is much rarer than 1930 pennies, 1852 Adelaide Pounds and even the most sought after 1813 Holey Dollars and Dumps.

# AUSTRALIA 2021 YEAR SETS

## 50<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY ABORIGINAL FLAG

The 2021 uncirculated and proof six coin year sets commemorate the 50th anniversary of the Australian Aboriginal Flag - a touchstone of our modern history, an official Flag of Australia and a symbol of pride and unity for our First Nations People.

The Australian Aboriginal Flag was first flown on 12 July 1971 at a land rights march in Adelaide's Victoria Square, and appeared again the following year at the beginnings of the Aboriginal Tent Embassy in Canberra. In 1995 the flag was proclaimed an official Flag of Australia and has proudly flown outside official buildings across the nation ever since.

These sets feature a specially designed coloured two dollar coin inspired by Harold Thomas' iconic Australian Aboriginal Flag. The 5¢, 10¢, 20¢, 50¢, \$1 & \$2 are struck to the mint's world class standards of quality.

# 60 YEARS OF AUSTRALIAN TOURING CAR CHAMPIONS

Australia enjoys an enduring love affair with Supercars racing, and this year celebrates 60 years of the Australian Touring Car Championship. The first Australian Touring Car Championship was held in 1960 at Gnoo Blas NSW, where the single-race title was won by David McKay driving a Jaguar.

An Australian-made car first won the ATCC in 1970 – the second year of the title being decided over a series of races – when a Holden Monaro GTS 350 ended a decade of dominance by British and American cars.

## ENCOUNTERING CURRENCY BEFORE 1800

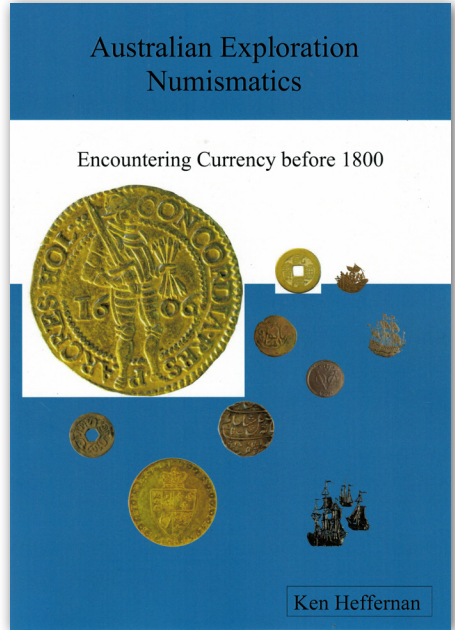
Compiled by Dr Ken Heffernan, this 194 page book uses contemporary coinage to illustrate the world with which Australia became increasingly intertwined in the early period of globalisation between 1606-1800.

Numismatic items, coins, tokens and medals, are inherently portable relics, and their dispersal can indicate extraordinary early networks. They are rich with iconography and texts that reflect the particular times and places of their manufacture.

Diverse places and people, directly and indirectly, became connected to Australia through exploration, shipwreck, commerce and settlement during these centuries.

These connections, whether to Africa, Asia, Europe, or the Americas, are often represented by coinage in the archaeological record of the island continent. Some links are to well-documented treasures but others remain mysterious, in the times before the land and its Aboriginal peoples had yet to experience the wider consequences of invasion.
