Off Licence

Issued under Sections 16 and 64 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) **Grunts Grog Company Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises situated at **1525 Waimea Highway, Mandeville, RD 6, Gore** and known as **Grunts Grog Company Limited** and deliver it somewhere else.



The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions:

- (a) The remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day.
- (b) Alcohol may only be delivered Monday to Sunday between the hours of 6.00am and 11.00pm.
- (c) No alcohol is to be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day of before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- (d) Internet ordering of alcohol must require the buyer to declare in two places that they and the recipient of the alcohol are both over 18 years of age.
- (e) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.
- (f) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the safe and responsible consumption of alcohol, and minimising alcohol related harm.
- (g) A copy of, or a link to, the licence must be prominently displayed on the website.

Duration:

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) either
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it was never renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on **13 August 2024.**
