Livos' Kunos Oil Sealer reinforces and deepens the natural colour of your saunas wood grain in the interior solid timber. Saunas with a cedar interior (Full Spectrum and Outdoor Models) will darken significantly. The Kunos Oil Sealer is transparent, glossy, water-resistant, with an open-pored finish. Our oil sealer produces a protective and nourishing surface film. The Kunos range available from Found Space is certified food safe.

Application is very simple. You will need the following:

- 25mm paint brush
- Steel wool
- Mineral turpentine
- Brush (to remove dust and debris)
- Using a clean brush from a brush and dustpan, brush down the heaters, seat and floor. Vacuum up any dust.
- 2. Give the tin of sealer a good shake for about 30 sec before opening.
- 3. Using a 25mm paint brush, apply the first coat to any of the following surfaces that you wish to treat: The face of timber slats in front of the heaters, the bench seat and the floor. Apply to the timber on the heaters first, followed by the seat and then floor. Ensure that there is not an excessive amount of oil on the brush to prevent runs and an uneven coat.
- 4. Clean brush with mineral turpentine and wrap in glad wrap.
- 5. Allow 1<sup>st</sup> coat to dry for at least 24 hours, until it feels completely dry to the touch.
- 6. Using steel wool wipe down all the coated surfaces, this will help with a smooth final coat.
- 7. Repeat step one before applying the 2nd coat.
- 8. Apply the 2<sup>nd</sup> coat as per *step 3*. Less oil will be required for the second coat.
- 9. Allow to dry for 24 hours before use.

You may notice a slight odour from the oil for the first few uses of the sauna; this is normal and completely safe. Every 6-12 months re-apply and use steel wool before application.
