1. Jiellâh by Susanna Kaartinen

Jiellâh is Inari Saami and means favourite. The polished look of this loose fitting cardigan is achieved with a few simple finishing touches.

The graphic but understated texture looks interesting and is both enjoyable to make and easy to style any way you wish!

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4) (5, 6, 7) (8, 9, 10)

Recommended ease: 8–12" / 20.5–30.5 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 38.75 (43, 46.75, 51.5) (55.25, 59.5, 63.25) (67, 70.75, 75.5)" / 98.5 (109, 119, 131) (140.5, 151, 161) (170, 180, 192) cm.

Body Length (from Hem to Top of Shoulder not incl Button Band): 20 (20, 20, 21.5) (21.5, 21.5, 23) (23, 23, 23)" / 51 (51, 51, 54.5) (54.5, 54.5, 58.5) (58.5, 58.5, 58.5) cm.

Length from Hem to Underarm: 10.5 (10, 9.75, 11) (10, 9, 9.75) (9, 8.75, 8.5)" / 26.5 (25.5, 25, 28) (25.5, 23, 25) (23.5, 22, 21.5) cm.

Sleeve Length (from Underarm): 17 (17, 17, 18.5) (18.5, 18.5, 19.75) (19.75, 19.75, 19.75)" / 43 (43, 43, 47) (47, 47, 50) (50, 50, 50) cm.

Upper Arm Circumference: 18 (18.75, 19.25, 20.25) (22, 24, 25.5) (27.25, 28.25, 29)" / 46 (47.5, 49, 51.5) (56, 61, 65) (69, 72, 73.5) cm.

Button Band Width: 1.75 (1.75, 1.75, 1.75) (1.75, 2, 2) (2, 2, 2)" / 4.5 (4.5, 4.5, 4.5) (4.5, 5, 5) (5, 5, 5) cm wide.

Hem length (slightly stretched): 2.5 (2.5, 2.5, 2.75) (2.75, 2.75, 3) (3, 3, 3)" / 6.5 (6.5, 6.5, 7) (7, 7, 7.5) (7.5, 7.5, 7.5) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: Yarn A: 3 (4, 4, 5) (5, 5, 6) (6, 6, 7) skeins of La Bien Aimée Twist Nouveau (100% non-superwash merino, 437 yds / 400 m — 100 g), colourway Oranje.

Or approx. 1310 (1440, 1530, 1780) (1900, 2040, 2300) (2430, 2550, 2680) yds / 1200 (1320, 1400, 1620) (1730, 1870, 2100) (2220, 2330, 2450) m of fingering-weight merino yarn.

Yarn B: 3 (3, 3, 4) (4, 4, 5) (5, 5, 5) skeins of La Bien Aimée Mohair Silk (70% mohair, 30% mulberry silk, 546 yds / 500 m – 50 g), colourway Hella.

Or approx. 1310 (1440, 1530, 1780) (1900, 2040, 2300) (2430, 2550, 2680) yds / 1200 (1320, 1400, 1620) (1730, 1870, 2100) (2220, 2330, 2450) m of lace-weight silk mohair.

Yarn A and Yarn B are held together throughout the pattern.

Needles: US 4 / 3.5 mm " / 100 cm circular needles (for button band), US 6 / 4 mm DPNS or preferred needles to work in small circumference (for cuffs), US 7 / 4.5 mm 40–60" / 100–150 cm circular needles (for body) and US 7 / 4.5 mm 16-24" / 40-60 cm (for sleeves).

Notions: Stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn, 3 buttons 1–1.25" / 25–30 mm in diameter.

GAUGE

Syncopated Shaker Stitch

15 sts x 36 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 7 / 4.5 mm needles with Yarns A and B held tog, after blocking with fabric relaxed.

Double Knit Button Band

38 sts x 52 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 4 / 3.5 mm needles with Yarns A and B held tog, after blocking with fabric relaxed.

2. Pladda by Rebecca Clow

Pladda is a top-down, raglan sweater with an all-over colourwork design. This was inspired by the idea of a cosy weekend in a cabin when the mornings and evenings are still chilly, and you want to be wrapped up in your favourite cosy blanket. The easy shape makes it versatile to wear whilst the graphic colourwork adds a cool and modern touch.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 0.75–2.25" / 2–6 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 30.5 (35.25, 40, 44.75, 49.5)(54, 59, 63.5, 68.25)" / 77.5 (89.5, 101.5, 113.5, 126) (137, 148, 161, 173.5) cm.

Upper Arm Circumference: 14 (15.25, 15.25, 17.5, 17.5) (20, 22.5, 23.5, 23.5)" / 35.5 (39, 39, 44.5, 44.5) (51, 57, 59.5, 59.5) cm.

Yoke Depth: 5.75 (6.25, 7,8.5,8)(6.5,7.8,7.5,8.25)" / 15 (16, 18, 21.5, 20)(16.5, 20, 19, 21) cm.

Length from Underarm to Hem: 13.5" / 34 cm.

Sleeve Length from underarm to cuff bind off: 17.25" / 44 cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: Le Gros Silk & Mohair by Biches & Bûches (72% Super Kid Mohair, 28% Mulberry Silk, 162 yds / 148 m – 50 g).

MC: 4 (4, 4, 5, 6)(6, 6, 7, 7) skeins of colourway Hay.

Or approx. 498 (586, 636, 731, 819] (919, 962, 1023, 1070) yds / 457 (537, 583, 671, 751) (844, 883, 939, 982) m of Aran-weight yarn.

CC: 3 (3, 4, 4, 5)(5, 5, 6, 6) skeins of colourway Dark Red.
Or approx. 404 (475, 516, 594, 665)(746, 781, 830, 869) yds / 371 (436, 473, 545, 610)(685, 694, 762, 797) m of Aran-weight yarn.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Brushed Alpaca by Sandnes Garn or any lace weight yarn, such as Le Petit Silk and Mohair by Biches & Bûches, Tillia by Filcolana or Tynn Silk Mohair by Sandnes Garn held double.

Needles: US 8 / 5 mm 16" / 40 cm and 24-40" / 60-100 cm circular needles and dpns (for the colourwork), US 6 / 4 mm circular needles 16" / 40 cm (for the neckline ribbing) and DPNS (for sleeve ribbing).

Notions: Tapestry needle, 8 stitch markers (inc. 1 distinct BOR marker), waste yarn or stitch holders.

GAUGE

17 sts x 22 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 8 / 5 mm needles in Colourwork Patt, after blocking.

3. Columns by Thea Vesterby

Columns is a sweater worked in a simple lace pattern with a high neck. This is the sweater you will reach for all year round. Wear it on a cold day at home, or outside walking the dog on a sunny day during Spring or Fall.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 4–6" / 10–15 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 36 (40,75, 43.5, 48, 52.75) (55.25, 60, 64.75, 67.25)" / 90 (102, 108, 120, 132) (138, 150, 162, 168) cm.

Length (from Back Neck): 21.5 (22.75, 23, 23, 23.5) (23.75, 24.75, 25.25, 26)" / 54.5 (57, 58, 58, 59.5) (60, 62, 63.5, 65) cm.

Upper Arm Circumference: 18 (20.5, 20.5, 20.5, 22.75) (22.75, 24, 24, 24)" / 45 (51, 51, 51, 57) (57, 60, 60, 60) cm.

Sleeve Length: 20 (20, 21, 21, 21, 21.25) (21.75, 21.75, 21.75, 21.75)" /50.5 (50.5, 53.5 53.5, 54) (55, 55, 55, 55) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 12 (13, 14, 15, 16) (17, 18, 19, 20) balls of My Soft One by Gepard Garn (100% merino, 98 yds / 90 m – 25 g) in the colourway 730.

Or approx. 1176 (1274, 1372, 1470, 1568) (1666, 1764, 1862, 1960) yds / 1080 (1170, 1260, 1350, 1440) (1530, 1620, 1710, 1800) m of heavy fingering / sport yarn.

Needles: US 4 / 3.5 mm 16–24" / 40–60 cm circular needles (for neckline and hem ribbing), US 2.5 / 3 mm (for sleeve cuffs) 16–24" / 40–60 cm circular needles and US 6 / 4 mm 32–40" / 80–100 cm circular needles (for body).

Notions: Stitch markers.

GAUGE

22 sts x 30 rnds to 4" / 10 cm on US 6 / 4 mm needles in St St, after blocking. 20 sts x 28 rnds to 4" / 10 cm on US 6 / 4 mm needles in Lace Patt, after blocking.

4. Sea Salt by Marion Mursic

Marion imagines the Sea Salt hoodie being worn at the end of a long afternoon by the sea, to warm you up after a swim. It is also the perfect companion for a promenade in the fields at sunset. The 2/3 sleeves make the hoodie easy to wear over your favourite summer dress.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 10–13.75" / 25.5–35 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 44.75 (49.5, 53.5, 57.5, 61.5) (65.5, 69.5, 73.5, 77.5)" / 112 (124, 134, 144, 154) (164, 174, 184, 194) cm.

Length from Mid Back Neckline to Hem: 22.5 (22.5, 23.25, 23.25, 24) (24, 25, 25, 25.5)" / 57 (57, 59, 59, 61) (61, 63.5, 63.5, 64.5) cm.

Sleeve Circumference at Armhole: 19.25 (20, 20.75, 21.5, 22.5) (23.25, 24, 24.75, 25.5)" / 48 (50, 52, 54, 56) (58, 60, 62, 64) cm.

Sleeve Length: 9.75 (10.25, 10.25, 10.75, 10.75) (11, 11, 11.75, 12.5)" / 24.5 (26, 26, 27, 27) (28, 28, 29.5, 31.5) cm.

Length of the Hood: 11.25 (11.25, 11.25, 11.75, 11.75) (11.75, 12, 12, 12)" / 28.5 (28.5, 28.5, 29.5, 29.5) (29.5, 30, 30, 30) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn:

6 (6, 7, 7, 8) (8, 8, 8, 9) skeins of La Bien Aimée Wensley Worsted (50% Falkland Corriedale, 25% Falkland Merino, 25% Wensleydale, 250 yds / 230 m – 100 g), colourway Lichen.

Or approx. 1312 (1465, 1629, 1749, 1859) (1913, 1968, 2000, 2100) yds / 1200 (1340, 1490, 1600, 1700) (1750, 1800, 1829, 1921) m of DK-weight yarn.

Leftovers of various colours of fingering-weight yarn for the embroidery. Alternative yarn suggestions for the DK-weight yarn are for example Ovis et Cetera Diminium, La Fée Fil BFL & Masham DK or By Night dyes Sirius DK.

Needles: US 6 / 4 mm circular needles, US 3 / 3.25 mm circular needles (for ribbing).

Notions: Stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn, embroidery needle.

GAUGE

20 sts x 29 rnds to 4" / 10 cm on US 6 / 4 mm needles in St St, after blocking.

5. Tepliy by Olga Putano

Tepliy is "warm" in Ukrainian. When it's time to pull out your warm, cozy sweaters for the cold seasons, this is the sweater I think of. That day there is a chill in the air and you need an extra layer to wear on your evening walk, Tepliy is there to provide that comfort while keeping you from overheating. Tepliy is the sweater you will be sad to put away for the summer, and it's the first one you'll wear when the weather allows.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4) (5, 6, 7, 8)

Recommended ease: 6–12" / 15-30.5 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 36 (42, 48, 54) (60, 66, 72, 78)" / 90 (105, 120, 135) (150, 165, 180, 195) cm.

Upper Sleeve Circumference: 15.5 (17, 18.5, 20) (21.5, 23, 24.5, 26)" / 39 (42.5, 46.5, 50) (54, 57.5, 61.5, 65) cm.

Front Body Length (underarm to hem): 13" / 32.5 cm.

Back Body Length (underarm to hem): 15" / 37.5 cm.

Sleeve Length: 17.5" / 44.5 cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 6 (6, 7, 8) (9, 10, 11, 11) skeins of Sōm DK by Camellia Fiber Co. (50% Pima Cotton, 42% Baby Alpaca, 8% Merino, 164 yds / 150 m – 50 g), colourway Clay Dust.

Or approx. 832 (971, 1109, 1248) (1387, 1525, 1664, 1803) yds / 761 (888, 1014, 1141) (1268, 1395, 1522, 1649) m of DK-weight yarn.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Cotton Merino Fine by Katia, Portobello by Hobbii, Softyak DK by Rowan or Feeling Good Yarn by Wool And The Gang.

Needles: US 3 / 3.25 mm circular needles and US 5 / 3.75 mm circular needles (for the ribbing) Note! The ribbing needles need to be 2 sizes larger than the main needle. You

will also need one needle 3 sizes larger than the main size, for the bind off. I used size US 6 / 4 mm.

Notions: Stitch markers, tapestry needle, scrap yarn or stitch holder.

GAUGE

16 sts x 32 rnds in 4" / 10 cm on US 3 / 3.25 mm needles in Charted Patt and in Garter St, after blocking.

6. Ottilia by Eliza Hinkes

The Ottilia scarf was inspired by a ready-to-wear designer sweater. It features a graphic lace pattern juxtaposed with fringe cleverly woven into eyelet columns. Pick muted colors for subtle texture, or use bright fringe for a fun pop in your outfit.

SIZE

One size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 13.5" / 33.5 cm

Length (excluding fringe): 71.25" / 178 cm

MATERIALS

Yarn:

MC: 9 skeins of Alpakka UII by Sandnes Garn (65% alpaca, 35% wool, 109 yds / 100 m – 50 g), colourway Camel.

CC: 1 skein of Sunday by Sandnes Garn (100% merino wool, 257 yds / 235 m - 50 g), colourway Cocoa Nib.

Or 981 yds / 900 m of worsted-weight yarn for MC and 150 yds / 137 m of fingering-weight yarn for CC.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Ultra Alpaca by Berroco, Highland Alpaca Worsted by Estelle Yarns or Wool of the Andes by KnitPicks (for MC), and Merino by Knitting for Olive, Peerie by Brooklyn Tweed or Palette by Knitpicks (for CC).

Needles: US 5 / 3.75 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles.

Notions: Stitch markers, spare circular needle.

GAUGE

22 sts x 31 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 5 / 3.75 mm needles in St St, after blocking.

7. Heligan by Qing Studio

Heligan is as simple as charming: the cables do all the work, creating a wonderful sense of movement as they cascade down the body. The sweater is worked from top to bottom, in the round. The increases are worked within the cables, so they almost double in size by the time you are finished. At the end comes the fun part where you unravel all the stitches between the cable columns setting the top free to swing around the body!

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: Approx. 4" / 10 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 32.25 (34, 39.5, 44, 47.75) (52.25, 55, 60.5, 64)" / 85 (90, 104.5, 116, 126.5) (138, 145, 159.5, 169) cm.

Neck Circumference: 33 (33, 33, 33, 36) (36, 36, 36, 36)" / 88 (88, 88, 88, 96) (96, 96, 96, 96) cm.

End of Yoke Circumference: 59.25 (62.5, 69.5, 73.75, 79.25) (87, 93.25, 98.75, 106.75)" / 156 (165, 183.5, 195, 209.5) (230, 246.5, 261, 282) cm.

Length of Yoke: 8.75 (9, 9.5, 9.75, 10) (10.5, 10.5, 12, 12)" / 22.5 (23.5, 24.5, 25, 25.5) (27, 27, 30.5, 30.5) cm.

Length from Underarm to Hem: 10. 75 (10. 75, 11.25, 11.75, 11.25) (10.75, 10.75, 11, 10.75)" / 28 (28, 29, 30, 29) (27.5, 27.5, 28.5, 27.5) cm.

Body Hem Circumference: 36 (39.5, 43, 48.25, 52.75) (56.5, 59.25, 64.75, 68.75)" / 95 (104.5, 114, 127.5, 139) (149.5, 156.5, 171, 182) cm.

Sleeve Length (Underarm to Cuff): 13 (14.75, 15.25, 14.75, 14.5) (14.25, 14.25, 12.5, 12.5)" / 33.5 (338, 39, 38.5, 37.5) (36.5,36.5, 32, 32) cm.

Upper Arm Circumference: 12 (12.75, 13.5, 13.5, 14.25) (16, 17.75, 17.75, 19.75)" / 32 (24, 36, 36, 38) (43, 47.5, 47.5, 52.5) cm.

Cuff Circumference: 12 (12.75, 12.75, 13.5, 14.25) (13.5, 13.5, 13.5, 13.75)" / 32 (34, 34, 36, 38) (36, 36, 36, 36.5) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 5 (5, 5, 6, 6) (7, 7, 8, 8) skeins of Kid Mohair Silk by Qing Fibre (70% mohair, 30% silk, 459 yds / 420 m – 50 g), colourway Mochi.

Or approx. 1759 (1887, 2144, 2285, 2431) (2630, 2762, 2972, 3145) yds / 1608 (1725, 1960, 2089, 2223) (2405, 2526, 2718, 2876) m of lace-weight yarn.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Qing Fibre Yak Singles or Qing Fibre Veranita.

Needles: US 9 / 5.5 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles. US 4 / 3.5 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles to work I-cord edging.

Notions: Stitch markers, cable needle, stitch holders or waste yarn, thin elastic approx. 50" / 127 cm in length (optional to add neckline I-cord for not wearing off-shoulder).

GAUGE

10 sts x 10 rnds to 1.5" / 4 cm width (widest part of cable) x 1.75" / 4.5 cm height on US 9 / 5.5 mm needles with 2 strands of yarn held tog.

1 dropped st measures between 0.5–0.75" / 1.5–2 cm (see stitch pattern).

8. Devana by Marzena Kołaczek

Devana (Polish: Dziewanna) is a Slavic goddess of wild nature. This ethereal, oversized and cropped top with dropped shoulders is designed to provide comfort while wearing. Textures mixed with delicate openwork guarantee fun during knitting and give the project a rustic, free character.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8) (9, 10, 11)

Recommended ease: 4–5.5" / 10–14 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 37.5 (41.25, 44.25, 48, 51) (54.75, 57.75, 61.5) (64.5, 68.25, 71.5)" / 94 (103, 111, 120, 127.5) (137, 144.5, 154) (161.5, 171, 178.5) cm.

Length from Shoulder to Hem: 15.5 (15.5, 15.5, 15.5, 17.25) (17.25, 17.25, 17.25) (19.25, 19.25, 19.25)" / 40.5 (40.5, 40.5, 40.5, 45.5) (45.5, 45.5, 45.5) (50.5, 50.5, 50.5) cm.

Length from Underarm to Hem: 9.5 (8.75, 8, 7.75, 8.75) (8.25, 8, 7.75) (9.5, 8.75,

8.25)" / 25 (22.5, 21, 20.5, 22.5) (21.5, 21, 20.5) (25, 22.5, 21.5) cm.

Arm Opening Circumference: 11.75 (13.5, 15, 15.5, 17.25) (18, 18.75, 19.25) (19.25, 21, 21.75)" / 31 (36, 39.5, 40.5, 46) (47.5, 49.5, 50.5) (50.5, 55.5, 57.5) cm.

Neckline Depth: 7 (7, 7, 7, 9) (9, 9, 9) (9, 9, 9)" / 18.5 (18.5, 18.5, 18.5, 23.5) (23.5, 23.5, 23.5, 23.5, 23.5, 23.5, 23.5) cm.

Shoulder Width: 7.5 (8.25, 8.5, 9, 9.5) (10.25, 11, 11.75) (12.75, 13.75, 14.25)" / 19 (20.5, 21, 22.5, 23.5) (26, 27.5, 29.5) (32, 34, 36) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 3 (4, 4, 4, 4) (4, 5, 5) (6, 6, 6) skeins of Tynn Line by Sandnes Garn (53% cotton, 33% viscose, 14% linen, 241 yds / 220 m – 50 g), in the colourway 9541.

Or approx. 719 (752, 787, 839, 894) (959, 1031, 1120) (1210, 1288, 1367) yds / 658 (688, 720, 767, 818) (877, 93, 1024) (1106, 1178, 1250) m of light fingering-weight yarn.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Pure Silk by Knitting for Olive, Tussah Tweed by BC Garn or Økologisk Pimabomuld by CaMaRose.

Needles: US 2.5 / 3 mm 40–60"/ 100–150 cm circular needles and US 1.5 / 2.5 mm 16–24"/ 40–60 cm circular needles.

Notions: 6 (6, 6, 6, 6) (6, 6, 6) (7, 7, 7) 3/8" / 1 cm diameter buttons, stitch holder.

GAUGE

26 sts x 44 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 2.5 / 3 mm needles in Seed St, after blocking.

9. Peppy by Lily Kate France

Lily loves the appearance of layers of squishy garter stitch. It's cosy, drapey, and always looks polished! This layered, asymmetric shape allowed her to introduce 3 colours in a minimal way, and gives the appearance of many layers of fabric without unnecessary bulk.

SIZES

Small (Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 41.5 (72.75)" / 104 (182) cm.

Height of the Triangle: 7.5 (13)" / 19 (32.5) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: Keld Fingering by Eden Cottage Yarns (90% superwash merino, 10% linen, 393 yds / 360 m – 100g).

1 skein of each of the 3 colourways Mellifer / C1 (cream), Heliotrope / C2 (pink), and Rust / C3 (brown).

Or approx. the following amounts of fingering-weight yarn: 124 (367) yds / 113 (336) m for C1 and C2, and 11 yds / 10 m of C3.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Merino Linen by Kokon Yarns and Dandelion by Madelinetosh.

Needles: US 5 / 3.75 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles, US 7 / 4.5 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles and an extra US 5 / 3.75 mm (or similar size) circular needle for the three-needle bind-off.

Notions: Removable stitch markers.

GAUGE

16 sts x 37 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 5 / 3.75 mm needles in Garter St, after blocking.

10. In Bloom by Joey Poh

These minimalistic floral-themed socks feature tiny flowers protected by a dainty trellis, encompassing that feeling of starting anew.

SIZES

1 (2, 3)

Recommended ease: 0.5–1" / 1.5–2.5 cm of negative ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Foot Circumference: 6.5 (7.75, 9)" / 16 (19.5, 22.5) cm.

Foot Length: 9 (9.75, 10.5)" / 22.5 (25, 26.5) cm (adjustable).

Leg Length: 5 (5.5, 6)" / 12.5 (13.5, 15) cm (adjustable).

MATERIALS

Yarn: Arwetta Classic by Filcolana (80% superwash merino wool, 20% nylon, 230 yds / 210 m – 50 g).

Main Colour (MC): 2 skeins of colourway 977 Marzipan Heather. Stem Colour (SC): 1 skein of colourway 243 Basswood Green. Flower Colour (FC): 1 skein of colourway 236 Red Clover.

Or approx. the following amounts of light fingering-weight yarn:

MC: 299 (347, 425) yds / 273 (317, 389) m.

SC: Scrap amounts. FC: Scrap amounts.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Stroll by Knit Picks, Heritage by Cascade Yarns or BFL Sock by Myrtle Yarn.

Needles: US 1 / 2.25 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles or DPNs.

Notions: Stitch markers, removable stitch marker, crochet hook (helpful but not necessary).

GAUGE

37 sts x 49 rnds to 4" / 10 cm on US 1 / 2.25 mm needles in St St, after blocking.
