1. QUINCE by Irene Lin

This sweater was designed with intricate floral patterns on the hem and sleeves. It combines elegance with a touch of nature-inspired beauty.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 1" / 2.5 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 41.25 (43.5, 45.75, 48, 50.25) (52.5, 57.25, 59.5, 64)" / 103 (108.5, 114.5, 120, 125.5) (131.5, 143, 148.5, 160) cm.

Neckline Circumference: 14.75 (15.5, 15.5, 16.5, 16.5) (16.5, 17.25, 17.25, 17.25)" / 37 (38.5, 38.5, 41.5, 41.5) (41.5, 43, 43, 43) cm.

Sleeve Length from Underarm: 17" / 42.5 cm.

Upper Arm Circumference: 13.75 (14.25, 14.25, 16, 16) (16, 18.25, 18.75, 20.5)" / 34.5 (35.5, 35.5, 40, 40) (40, 45.5, 47, 51.5) cm.

Body Length from Underarm: 10.25" / 26 cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 5 (6, 6, 7, 7) (8, 8, 9, 9) balls of Soft Silk Mohair by Knitting for Olive (70% mohair, 30% silk, 246 yds / 225 m – 25 g), in the colourways Quince (yellow sample) and Soft Peach (peach sample).

Or approx. 1230 (1345, 1476, 1596, 1722) (1837, 1968, 2088, 2214) yds / 1125 (1230, 1350, 1459, 1575) (1680, 1800, 1909, 2024) m of lace-weight yarn.

4 (5, 5, 6, 6) (7, 7, 8, 8) balls of Merino by Knitting for Olive (100% merino, 273 yds / 250 m – 50 g), in the colourways Quince (yellow sample) and Soft Peach (peach sample).

Or approx. 1230 (1345, 1476, 1596, 1722) (1837, 1968, 2088, 2214) yds / 1125 (1230, 1350, 1459, 1575) (1680, 1800, 1909, 2024) m of light fingering-weight yarn.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Wild & Soft by Gepard Garn held together with Kid Seta by Gepard Garn, Midnatssol by CaMaRosa held together with Yaku by

CaMaRose or Linum by The Uncommon Thread held together with Cloud Fingering by The Uncommon Thread.

Needles: US 6 / 4 mm 16–48" / 40–120 cm circular needles for the body and sleeves according to the requirements of each section.

US 4 / 3.5 mm DPNs or long circular needles (if you magic-loop) for the neckband and cuffs.

Notions: Stitch markers, removable stitch markers, cable needle, stitch holders or waste yarn.

GAUGE

22 sts x 29 rnds = 4" / 10 cm on US 6 / 4 mm needles in St St, after blocking.

28 sts x 26 rnds = 4" / 10 cm on US 6 / 4 mm needles in Twisted Ribbing Patt, after blocking.

2. IMATRA by Fiona Alice

While Fiona is often drawn to designing garments for the winter months, she feels this colour block cardigan would be perfect for the warmer seasons. Especially, during Finland's summer, this cardigan is to be pulled on during late evening at the summer cottage or while taking the ferry to Suomenlinna for a picnic. The reddish and pinky hues reminded her of the pink-plaster barracks found all over Suomenlinna.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 12–14" / 30.5–35.5 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 45.25 (49.25, 53.25, 57.25, 61.25) (65.25, 69.25, 73.25, 77.25)" / 113.5 (123.5, 133.5, 143.5, 153.5) (163.5, 173.5, 183.5, 193.5) cm.

Full Length: 23.25 (23.25, 23.25, 24.25, 24.25) (24.25, 25.75, 25.75, 25.75)" / 59 (59, 59, 61.5, 61.5) (61.5, 65.5, 65.5, 65.5) cm.

Side Seam Length: 14.25 (14, 13.75, 14.5, 14.25) (14, 15.25, 15, 14.75)" / 36 (35.5, 35, 36.5, 36) (35.5, 38.5, 38, 37.5) cm.

Sleeve Length: 16.5 (16.5, 16.5, 16, 16) (16, 15.5, 15.5, 15.5)" / 42 (42, 42, 40.5, 40.5) (40.5, 39.5, 39.5, 39.5) cm.

Upper Arm Circumference: 16.25 (16.75, 17, 17.75, 18.72) (18.75, 19, 19.75, 20.25)" / 41 (41.5, 42.5, 44, 46) (46.5, 47.5, 49, 51) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 13 (14, 14, 17, 17) (20, 21, 23, 24) skeins of Duo by Sandnes Garn (55% merino wool, 45% cotton, 126 yds / 115 m – 50 g).

Yarn A: 5 (5, 5, 6, 6) (7, 8, 8, 9) skeins of colourway 4344.

Or approx. 525 (569, 623, 683, 749) (820, 902, 990, 1088) yds / 480 (520, 570, 625, 685) (750, 825, 905, 995) m of DK-weight yarn.

Yarn B: 4 (4, 4, 5, 5) (6, 6, 7, 7) skeins of colourway 3522.

Or approx. 421 (459, 503, 552, 607) (667, 733, 809, 875) yds / 385 (420, 460, 505, 555) (610, 670, 740, 800) m of DK-weight yarn.

Yarn C: 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) (7, 7, 8, 8) skeins of colourway 3536.

Or approx. 486 (536, 590, 650, 711) (782, 858, 940, 1006) yds / 444 (490, 539, 594, 650) (715, 785, 860, 920) m of DK-weight yarn.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example De Rerum Natura Robinson, Brooklyn Tweed Arbor and Brooklyn Tweed Dapple.

Needles: US 4 / 3.5 mm 32" / 80** cm circular needles, an extra US 4 / 3.5 mm needle for the 3-Needle BO, US 2.5 / 3 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles.

**A longer circular needle may be more comfortable for sizes 7, 8 and 9.

Notions: 3 locking stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn, three 0.75" / 2 cm buttons, blocking mats and t-pins.

GAUGE

24 sts x 28 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 4 / 3.5 mm needles in St St, after blocking.

3. CASADINHO SLIPOVER by Paula Pereira

The Casadinho Slipover is worked in stockinette stitch. It features beautiful details, such as the i-cord edging around the armholes and the small pleats at the underarms. Knitted with an airy yarn on larger needles, this one is a quick knit. Wear the slipover either on its own or combined with the cardigan as a classic twinset.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 2–3" / 5–7.5 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 32 (36.75, 40.5, 44.25, 48) (52.75, 56.5, 60.25, 65)" / 80 (92, 101, 110.5, 120) (132, 141, 150.5, 162.5) cm.

Underarm to Hem: 10.5 (10.5, 10.5, 10.25, 10.25) (10.25, 10, 10, 10)" / 26.5 (26.5, 26.5, 26, 26) (26, 25.5, 25.5, 25.5) cm.

Neckline Circumference: 17 (17, 18, 18, 18.75) (18.75, 18.75, 19.75, 19.75)" / 42.5 (42.5, 44.5, 44.5, 47) (47, 47, 49.5, 49.5) cm.

Armhole Depth: 7.75 (8.25, 8.75, 9.5, 10.5) (11.5, 11.75, 12, 12.5)" / 19.5 (20.5, 22, 24, 26.5) (29, 29, 30, 31.5) cm.

Total Length: 18.25 (18.75, 19.25, 19.75, 20.75) (21.75, 21.75, 22, 22.5)" / 46 (47, 48.5, 50, 52.5) (55, 54.5, 55.5, 57) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 3 (4, 4, 5, 5) (6, 6, 7, 7) balls of Snefnug by CaMaRose (55% alpaca, 35% cotton 10% merino, 120 yds / 110 m – 50 g), colourway 7315 Grå Beige.

Or approx. 323 (379, 432, 476, 559) (626, 674, 724, 803) yds / 296 (347, 395, 436, 512) (573, 617, 662, 735) m of DK to worsted-weight yarn (be sure to swatch and meet gauge).

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Isager Eco Soft, Miltons Ronron and Biches & Bûches Le Coton & Alpaca.

Needles: US 8 / 5 mm and US 6 / 4 mm 24" / 60 cm circular needles.

Notions: Stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn, cable needle.

GAUGE

17 sts x 24 rnds to 4" / 10 cm on US 8 / 5 mm needles in St St, after blocking.

4. CASADINHO CARDIGAN by Paula Pereira

Paula Pereira is drawn to the variety of ways to wear a classic twinset. Her Casadinho Cardigan can be worn both on its own or together with the slipover of the same name. The cardigan features a textured rib pattern that looks stunning yet is easy to knit. The practical pockets add a finishing touch.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 2–2.5" / 5–6.5 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 32.75 (36.75, 40.75, 44.75, 48.75) (52.5, 56.75, 60.75, 64.75)" / 82 (92, 102, 112, 122) (132, 142, 152, 162) cm.

Each Front Width: 9.75 (10.75, 11.75, 12.75, 13.75) (14.75, 15.75, 16.75, 17.75)" / 24 (26.5, 29, 31.5, 34) (36.5, 39, 41.5, 44) cm.

Back Width: 16.5 (18.5, 20.5, 22.5, 24.5) (26.5, 28.5, 30.5, 32.5)" / 41 (46, 51, 56, 61) (66, 71, 76, 81) cm.

Fronts Overlap: 1.5" / 3.5 cm.

Body (Underarm to Hem): 12.5" / 32 cm.

Upper Arm Circumference: 11 (12, 13, 14, 15) (17, 18, 20, 21)" / 27.5 (30, 32.5, 35, 37.5) (42.5, 45, 50, 52.5) cm.

Sleeve Length: 20.25 (19, 18.5, 17.5, 16.75) (15.75, 15.25, 13.75, 13.5)" / 50.5 (47.5, 46.5, 43.5, 42) (39.5, 38, 34.5, 33.5) cm.

Cuff Circumference: 8 (8.5, 8.75, 8.75, 9.25) (9.5, 10, 10.75, 11.25)" / 20 (21, 22, 22, 23) (24, 25, 27, 28) cm.

Shoulder Shaping: 0.75" / 2 cm.

Total Length: 18.25 (19, 19.5, 20, 20.75) (21.25, 21.75, 23, 23.5)" / 46.5 (48, 49.5, 51, 52.5) (54, 55, 58, 59.5) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 8 (8, 9, 10, 11) (12, 13, 14, 14) balls of Snefnug by CaMaRose (55% alpaca, 35% cotton, 10% merino, 120 yds / 110 m – 50 g), colourway 7315 Grå Beige.

Or approx. 845 (932, 1020, 1119, 1208) (1357, 1446, 1584, 1673) yds / 773 (852, 933, 1023, 1105) (1241, 1322, 1448, 1530) m of DK to worsted-weight yarn (be sure to swatch and meet gauge).

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Isager Eco Soft, Miltons Ronron and Biches & Bûches Le Coton & Alpaca.

Needles: US 6 / 4 mm and US 7 / 4.5 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles and an extra US 7 / 4.5 mm needle for 3-Needle BO, US 7 / 4.5 mm DPN or longer circular needles (for Magic Loop), US 6 / 4 mm DPNs or longer circular needles (for sleeves).

Notions: Stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn.

GAUGE

20 sts x 28 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 7 / 4.5 mm needles in st patt, after blocking.

24 sts x 28 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 7 / 4.5 mm needles in 1 x 1 Rib, after blocking.

5. TSINNIA by Jenny Ansah

Tsinnia is Finnish for Zinnia flower. The exploration of colour and shape variations of Zinnias brings Jenny all her happy places in Helsinki – botanical and domestic gardens which breathe life into her. Tsinnia is the perfect little scarf for cool summer days where you need something small to warm your torso. You may also use it as a head scarf to protect you from the sun.

SIZE

One size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 34.5" / 86 cm.

Width: 8.25" / 20.5 cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 2 skeins of Preseli by Garthenor (100% wool, 219 yds / 200 m – 50 g), in the colourway Raspberry.

Or approx. 241 yds / 220 m of fingering-weight yarn.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Filcolana Merci, Xolla Wool Pastoreta or De Rerum Natura Albertine.

Needles: US 4 / 3.5 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles.

Notions: Cable needle (if needed).

GAUGE

32 sts x 29 rows to 4" / 10 cm of Textured Patt knitted flat, after blocking without stretching.

6. BRISA AL ATARDECER by Griselda Zárate

Brisa al Atardecer, meaning breeze at sunset in Spanish, is a delicate pullover design that aims to capture the soft feeling of happy summer days with an all-over star lace stitch pattern. With a slightly boxy and cropped fit, the pullover is knitted with two strands of yarn held together. This is a charming garment design that will be a joy to knit, and definitely to wear.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9) (10)

Recommended ease: 4" / 10 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust Circumference: 33 (35.75, 40.25, 43.75, 48.25) (51.75, 56.25, 59.75, 64.25) (67.75)" / 83 (89.5, 100.5, 109.5, 120.5) (129.5, 140.5, 149.5, 160.5) (169.5) cm.

Upper Arm Circumference: 16.25 (17, 18, 19, 19.75) (20.75, 21.5, 22.5, 22.25) (23.25)" / 40.5 (43, 45, 47, 49.5) (51.5, 54, 56, 58.5) (58.5) cm.

Body Length from Underarm to Hem: 12.25 (12.25, 12.25, 12.25, 12.75) (12.75, 12.25, 12.25, 12.25) (12.25)" / 31 (31, 31, 31, 32) (32, 31, 31, 31) (31) cm.

Sleeve Length from Underarm to Cuff: 20.5 (20.5, 21, 22, 22) (22.5, 22.5, 23, 24.25) (25.25)" / 51 (51, 52.5, 55, 55) (56, 56, 57, 60.5) (63) cm.

Front Neck Drop: 5.75 (5.75, 6.5, 7.5, 8.5) (9, 10, 10.25, 11.25) (12.25)" / 14 (14, 16.5, 19, 21) (22.5, 24.5, 26, 28) (30.5) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 5 (5, 5, 6, 7) (7, 8, 8, 9) (10) skeins of Tweed by Isager (70% wool, 30% mohair, 219 yds / 200 m – 50 g), colourway Lime.

Or approx. 939 (1011, 1084, 1264, 1408) (1517, 1625, 1733, 1842) (1986) yds / 859 (925, 991, 1156, 1287) (1387, 1486, 1585, 1684) (1816) m of fingering-weight yarn.

3 (3, 3, 4, 4) (4, 5, 5, 5) (6) of Trio 1 by Isager (50% linen, 30% cotton, 20% bamboo, 383 yds / 350 m – 50 g), colourway Green Tea.

Or approx. 939 (1011, 1084, 1264, 1408) (1517, 1625, 1733, 1842) (1986) yds / 859 (925, 991, 1156, 1287) (1387, 1486, 1585, 1684) (1816) m of lace-weight yarn.

The yarns are held together throughout the pattern.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Tahki Yarns Donegal Tweed Fine, Queensland Kathmandu Fingering and Brooklyn Tweed Loft for the fingering-weight yarn and Go Handmade Tencel Bamboo Extra Fine, Vegan Yarn Libertas Lace and Artisan Yarns Linen Lace for the lace-weight yarn.

Needles: US 4 / 3.5 mm and US 9 / 5.5 mm 32" / 80 cm or longer circular needles, US 9 / 5.5 mm crochet hook.

Notions: Stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn.

GAUGE

18 sts x 17 rnds to 4" / 10 cm on US 9 / 5.5 mm needles in Lace Star St Patt, after blocking.

7. ZIGGY by Julia Wilkens

The striking Ziggy shawl is the result of the designer Julia Wilkens experimenting with a zig-zag shape. She was very drawn to the little dance of low-key garter stitch and the frivolous loopy stitch. The design got its name from the iconic cover of the album Aladdin Sane by David Bowie. The famous cover features Bowie with a lightning bolt painted across his face.

SIZE

One size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 94.5" / 240 cm.

Width: 19.75" / 50 cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 2 skeins of Spinni by Isager (100% Pure New Wool, 656 yds / 600 m – 100 g), colourway 6s (MC) and 1 skein each of Spinni by Isager (100% Pure New Wool, 328 yds / 300 m – 50 g), colourways 44 and 39s (CC1 and CC2).

Note! Isager Spinni is sold in two different skein sizes. You only need a small amount for the contrast colours, which is why it's advisable to get the 50 gram skeins for those.

Or approx. 1039 yds / 950 m for MC and 87 yds / 80 m for each CC of lace-weight yarn.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Saga by Filcolana, Modena by Lamana, Coast by Holst Garn or Supersoft by Holst Garn.

Needles: US 2.5 / 3 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles.

Notions: Stitch markers, 1 removable stitch marker, sturdy rectangular object (for example a small book) of approx. 6" / 15 cm wide and 1" / 2.5 cm thick (for making tassel).

GAUGE

23 sts x 40 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 2.5 / 3 mm needles in Garter St, after blocking.

8. FACETTE by Faïza Mebazaa

Facette is a feminine sweater with special shaping details and delicate colourwork additions. Faïza wanted to design a garment that was gracious with an easy attitude, and a shaping feature that wouldn't be seen elsewhere. While the body remains very simple, the sleeves catch the eye with their gentle geometry. The motif and embroidered lines provide subtle accents and the pleasure to play with colours.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 2.5–6.5" / 6–16 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 34.75 (38.75, 42.5, 46.5, 50.25) (54, 58, 63.75, 67.5)" / 87 (97, 106.5, 116, 125.5) (135, 145, 159, 169) cm.

Body Length (at centre back): 19.75 (20.25, 21.25, 22, 22.75) (23.5, 24.5, 24.75, 25.5)" / 49.5 (50.5, 53, 55, 57) (59, 61, 62, 63.5) cm.

Sleeve Length (from shoulder): 17.5 (18.25, 19, 19.75, 20.5) (21.25, 22, 22.5, 23)" / 43.5 (45.5, 47.5, 49.5, 51) (53, 55, 56, 57.5) cm.

Sleeve Circumference at Widest Point: 17.25 (17.25, 17.25, 19.25, 21.25) (21.25, 21.25, 23, 23)" / 43 (43, 43, 48, 53) (53, 53, 57.5, 57.5) cm.

Sleeve Circumference at Mid-Forearm: 11.5 (11.5, 11.5, 12.75, 14) (14, 14, 15.5, 15.5)" / 29 (29, 29, 32, 35) (35, 35, 38.5, 38.5) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: Sock Fine by Mominoki (75% Merino wool, 25% Polyamide, 437 yds / 400 m – 100 g).

MC: 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) (5, 5, 5, 6) skeins of colourway Antique Ivory.

CC1: 1 skein of colourway Firefly.

CC2: 1 skein of colourway Lavender.

Or approx. the following amounts of fingering-weight yarn:

MC: 1028 (1141, 1295, 1440, 1600) (1762, 1933, 2068, 2217) yds / 940 (1043, 1184, 1317, 1463) (1611, 1768, 1891, 2027) m.

CC1: 104 (111, 118, 130, 142) (149, 157, 168, 176) yds / 95 (101, 108, 119, 130) (136, 144, 154, 161) m.

CC2: 54 (58, 62, 68, 75) (78, 82, 88, 92) yds / 49 (53, 57, 62, 69) (71, 75, 80, 84) m.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example The Plucky Knitter Solo Fingering, The Uncommon Thread Alpaca Sock or Meadow Yarn Cooms Fingering.

Needles: US 3 / 3.25 mm circular needles (16"/ 40 cm, 24"/ 60 cm and 32-40"/ 80-100 cm) and DPNs (or preferred method for working small circumferences in the round).

Notions: US E / 3.5 mm crochet hook, 8 stitch markers (one of a different colour for BOR).

GAUGE

25 sts x 36 rows to 4" / 10 cm in St St, after blocking.

25 sts x 34 rows to 4" / 10 cm in Stranded Colourwork Patt, after blocking.

9. FOSSORA by Soraya García

Fossora is a summer essential that blends elegance and freshness. Inspired by intricate crochet stitches, this unique top is crafted with organic cotton, creating a delightful interplay of knitting techniques. Fossora evokes the sweet nostalgia of an After Eight ice cream, making it a charming addition to your summer wardrobe.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9, 10)

Recommended ease: 1–1.5" / 2.5–4 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust Circumference: 30.75 (34.25, 38.75, 43.5, 46.75) (51.5, 54.75, 59.5, 62.75, 67.5)" / 77 (85.5, 97, 108.5, 117) (128.5, 137, 148.5, 157, 168.5) cm.

Hem Circumference: 36.5 (41.25, 44.5, 49.25, 52.5) (57.25, 61.75, 65.25, 69.75, 73.25)" / 91.5 (103, 111.4, 123, 131.5) (143, 154.5, 163, 174.5, 183) cm.

Total Length: 22 (22, 23, 23, 23) (23.5, 23.5, 24.25, 25.5, 25.75)" / 55 (55, 57.5, 58, 58) (59, 59.5, 61, 64.5, 65) cm.

Body Length (from Underarm to Hem): 13 (12.75, 13, 12.5, 12) (12, 11.75, 12, 12.75, 13)" / 32.5 (32, 32.5, 31.5, 30) (30, 29.5, 30, 32, 32.5) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: Fine Organic Cotton by Musa Yarn (100% organic cotton, 197 yds / 180 m – 50 g).

2 (3, 3, 3, 3) (4, 4, 4, 5, 5) balls of each colour:

C1: 54 Laurel Green.

C2: 60 Sandshell.

C3: 99 Black Beauty.

Or approx. 343 (395, 451, 509, 558) (607, 666, 720, 799, 849) yds / 314 (361, 412, 465, 510) (555, 609, 658, 731, 776) m of fingering-weight yarn.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Knitting for Olive Cotton Merino, Camarose Økologisk Sommeruld and Rowan Summerlite 4 Ply.

Needles: US 4 / 3.5 mm 32" / 80 cm and 8" / 20 cm circular needles, US 5 / 3.75 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles.

Notions: Removable markers.

GAUGE

14 sts x 31 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 5 / 3.75 mm needles in English Rose Tweed holding two strands of yarn together, after blocking.

10. SPECULAAS by Kaori Katsurada

"Speculaas," as the name suggests, is a sock pattern inspired by Belgian spice cookies. The warm brown color of the socks brings cinnamon in mind and the socks are decorated with exquisite cookie-like stitches.

SIZES

1 (2, 3)

Recommended ease: 1.5" / 4 cm negative ease on foot circumference and 0.5" / 1.5 cm negative ease on foot length.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Foot Circumference: 7 (8, 9)" / 17.5 (20, 22.5) cm.

Foot Length: Adjustable.

Leg Length: Approx. 4.25" / 10.5 cm (adjustable).

MATERIALS

Yarn: 1 (1, 1) skein of BFL Sock by Woodland Garden (75% Superwash BFL, 25% Nylon, 465 yds / 425 m –100 g), colourway Speculoos.

Or approx. 256 (305, 375) yds / 234 (279, 343) m of fingering-weight yarn. Yardage is calculated for a leg length of 4" / 10 cm.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Sock Yarn by Isager or Fine Sock by Life in the Long Grass.

Needles: US 1 / 2.25 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needle.

Notions: 2 stitch markers, cable needle.

GAUGE

32 sts x 44 rnds to 4" / 10 cm in St St, after blocking.

11. LUCIENNE by Audrey Borrego

Lucienne is a light pullover with wide lacy raglan and $\frac{3}{4}$ length sleeves. The graphic pattern combined with the slight boat neck shaping and the cropped body make a versatile garment for warmer seasons.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 2–4" / 5–10 cm of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 33.5 (37.75, 42, 46.25, 50.75) (54.5, 59.25, 63.75, 68.25)" / 85 (95.5, 106, 116.5, 128) (137.5, 149, 160.5, 171.5) cm.

Raglan Depth: 7.5 (8.5, 8.75, 9, 9.25) (9.75, 10, 11, 11.25)" / 19 (21, 21.5, 22.5, 23) (24.5, 25, 27, 28) cm.

Upper Arm Circumference: 11.5 (13, 14.5, 15.25, 16.5) (17.5, 18.25, 19.75, 21)" / 28.5 (32.5, 36, 38, 41) (44, 45.5, 49.5, 52.5) cm.

Underarm to Hem Length: 11.75" / 30 cm.

Sleeve Length: 13.5" / 34.5 cm.

Upper Back Width: 11 (13, 13.75, 15.5, 16.75) (18.75, 20.5, 22.5, 24)" / 27.5 (32.5, 34.5, 39, 42) (46.5, 51.5, 56, 60) cm.

Back Neck Width: 3 (3.5, 3.75, 4.25, 5) (5.25, 6, 6.75, 7.5)" / 7.5 (8.5, 9.5, 10.5, 12.5) (13.5, 15, 17, 19) cm.

MATERIALS

Yarn: 5 (5, 5, 6, 7) (8, 8, 9, 9) balls of De Rerum Natura Candide (70% non superwash arles merino, 30% recycled cotton, 202 yds / 185 m – 50 g), colourway Sirène.

Or approx. 855 (905, 1010, 1185, 1315) (1455, 1585, 1695, 1785) yds / 780 (830, 925, 1085, 1200) (1330, 1450, 1550, 1630) m of sport-weight yarn.

Alternative yarn suggestions are for example Galileo by Knit Picks or Sommeruld by Pickles.

Needles: US 5 / 3.75 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles and US 3 / 3.25 mm 32" / 80 cm circular needles.

Notions: Stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn, cable needle (optional).

GAUGE

21 sts x 29 rnds to 4" / 10 cm on US 5 / 3.75 mm needles in St St, after blocking.

Lace panel: 16 sts x 14 rnds = 2.5 x 1.75" / 6.5 x 4.5 cm on US 5 / 3.75 mm needles, after blocking.
