Bullseye Turning Supply Hobby Knife Turning Instructions

Supplies Required:

Drill Bits: 8mm

Bushings: Compatible With Tiny Giant/Editor

Personal Protective Equipment

3/4" x 3/4" x >4" Blank

Recommended:

Pen Jaws Or Collets To Drill On The Lathe Live & Dead Centers + TBC Bushings

Getting Started

Included in the kit is a craft knife from Excel Knives, pre-disassembled for you, as well as an Ø8mm x 94.5mm tube



Please be careful when you unscrew the parts as the knife blade is VERY sharp

- 1. Measure your desired blank so that it is just slightly longer than the length of the tube.
- 2. Drill out the blank using an 8mm drill bit
- 3. *If* using a resin or acrylic blank, paint the inside of the drilled hole a complimentary color. Let Dry.
- 4. Glue tube into the blank & let cure. We recommend 5-min epoxy for extended working time.
- 5. Square the ends of the blank so they are flush with the tube. We recommend a sanding jig for this operation, but you can also use a barrel trimmer.
- 6. Using the bushings, turn blank to desired shape/size.
- 7. Sand & polish using the finish of your choice.
- 8. Press the aluminum collar into one end. It should fit very snug, and possibly shear part of the aluminum "teeth" off. place the blade holder into the collar.
- 9. Install the shaft of the knife into the opposite end of the handle. Thread the shaft into the collar and install the blade.
