Here's your NEW RouteCan!

Each RouteCan Kit Includes:

1 RouteCan: a 1 gal "can" made in the USA from recycled polypropylene plastic, with a hand-made wood handle and Hi-Viz reflective tape and logo on each side.

1 Divider Table: made with 2" ABS plastic pipe and a 0.1" x 5" square, to separate the 2 rolls!

1 Whisk Broom: to sweep away the dust and sand at all the *RouteArrow* placement location spots.

1 Green RouteArrows Logo Ballpoint Pen: to easily write some notes and stuff when needed.

1 RouteArrows Star Logo Sticker: for your laptop, or your car's rear window or on your water bottle!

How to Use this Wonderfully Unique Hand-Made Tool

- Remove the white "Please Remove..." stickers from the outside of the *RouteArrows* rolls, to free the end.
- Insert the first roll into the RouteCan, "right-side-up" with the *RouteArrows* logo text on the lower edge.
- Once it's in the can push about 4-5 inches of the end of the tape out through the vertical feed slot.
- If you are only using ONE roll, you are ready to go Route Marking, but if you are using TWO Rolls...
- Lower the divider table into can, at an angle, cylinder first, down into the center of the first roll.
- Press the table down so it's at the bottom, table corners just touching the inside walls of the RouteCan.
- Insert the second roll of *RouteArrows*, also logo edge down, and push 4-5 inches out, same as the first roll.
- To dispense *RouteArrows*, set the can down on the ground or car hood, with one hand on the handle.
- Use your other hand to pull out the needed length of *RouteArrows*, one or both ends of the rolls.
- To separate the *RouteArrows* from the backing, start at the tip then fold a bit then peel off each arrow.
- Place each *RouteArrow* on the ground after peeling it off and sweeping the dust, one at a time, as needed.
- Tear off the backing paper every few arrows, wading it up and put it into a bag kept in the vehicle.

More Helpful Tips and Info:

- It is faster and easier to place arrows in teams of two: one feeding and one sweeping and placing them down.
- Work facing traffic, with the Hi-Viz Yellow reflector tape facing forward for added visibility and safety.
- When using TWO different colors, load the most used color on top (last) to easily reload it when needed.
- When using ONE roll, "store" the divider table in the RouteCan, loaded first, upside down, under the roll.
- We recommend tearing off and bagging the backing paper when you get back to the vehicle.
- Store your RouteCan indoors, at room temps, in the box or out of direct sunlight.
- The wood handle is finished with Polyurethane and should provide many years of use.
