The Naches Heights AVA, itself a subappellation of the Columbia Valley AVA. Situated between 1200-2100 ft elevation on a gently sloping plateau of million-year-old volcanic soils, the AVA is one of the highest in Washington, and experiences much cooler temperatures than the rest of the state, despite receiving as many days of sun as anywhere in Washington's grape growing regions. This combination of sun and cooler temperatures ensures even ripening for the fruit. First planted in 2002, the AVA is known for its intense commitment to organic and biodynamic farming. Naches Heights Vineyard is nestled in the AVA, and is practicing organic, biodynamic, and Salmon Safe.
