

# How to use safely



Read the instructions carefully before use.



Do not place on materials prone to deformation at high temperature, such as leather sofas or latex mattresses.



Do not apply strong force or excessive weight. Do not disassemble or modify the inner part of the device.



Keep out of reach of the children and do NOT let them operate the device.



Do not use alcohol, benzene, acetone or other chemicals.



Remove any metal jewelry from the area the device would touch before use.

## Precautions on Use

## Warnings and precautions for charging

#### Warning

- Do not use or charge for long hours on or under the blanket, electric heating pad, or carpet.
- Internal temperature increase may cause damage or fire.

#### **⚠** Caution

- Stop using if there is smoke or strange odor.
   Turn the power off immediately, remove the charger adapter and contact the Place you purchase.
- Continued use may result in fire or electric shock.
- · Do not damage, modify, bend, twist, or apply heat to the charger adapter or USB cable.
  - Damaged cord may cause fire or electric shock.
- Do not put conductor materials in the electrical outlet when the charger adapter is plugged in.
- · Do not touch directly after unplugging the charger adapter.
  - It may result in electric shock.
- · Unplug the charger adapter by pulling the plug, not the cable.
- Pulling the cable may cause damage or short circuit.
- Not recommended for more than 2 hours of use while charging, as it can damage the battery.

# Warnings and precautions on usage

## Warning

- · Do not disassemble, alter or modify the product.
  - Malfunction may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- Be careful that the product contains the magnetic material, which may affect the credit card.
- · This product is not waterproof. Keep away from moisture.
- · Do not touch the charger cable with wet hands.
- It may result in electric shock.
- Recommended to be used on a chair or flat surface. Do not use near materials prone to deformation at high temperature.
- $\cdot$  Do not cover the product with a blanket when it is operating.
- · Do not drop or apply strong force. Keep away from vibrations or magnets.
- $\cdot$  Unplug the power cable by pulling the plug, not the cord.
  - Pulling the cord may damage the electric cable or cause the device to fall.
- $\cdot$  Beware when using in dry air.
- Be aware of static electricity when using in a place with dry air.
- Static electricity can be prevented by touching metal before using the product.
- $\cdot$  Do not place near heat or fire.
- · Do not use or store near flammable materials.
- It may cause fire or explosion.
- · Do not use high voltage electrical products (e.g. electric mosquito bats) near the device.
  - Electrical shock may damage to the product.

## Warnings and precautions on battery

#### Warning

- · Damaged battery may result in explosion.
- · Do not apply strong force, put in water, or keep or use for long hours in the car or sauna.
- · Built-in battery cannot be removed or replaced arbitrarily by the user. Improper battery exchange may result in explosion.
- · Battery shall be disposed in accordance with the local disposal procedures.

- · This product has the battery built into the device.
- Fully charge the battery before first use.
- · Batteries are consumable items, therefore battery life decreases over time.
- · Charging time may change depending on the remaining battery time, temperature, or other conditions.
- · Built-in battery cannot be removed or replaced arbitrarily by the user. In such case, guaranteed service shall not apply.
- · When it is necessary to remove or replace the battery, always visit the designated service center.
- · Removing or replacing the battery in a normal product may incur a service fee.

It takes approximately 10 hours 30 minutes to fully charge a depleted battery (main body + Y pad), and the power consumption is 45W.

# Warnings and precautions on product storage

## **M** Warning

- · Keep away from heater or high temperature.
  - There is a risk of fire.
- · Do not store near electric heater or at high temperatures.
  - There is a risk of fire or damage.
- · Do not store in humid, dusty or sooty areas.
  - There is a risk of fire or electric shock.

## **⚠** Caution

- · Do not expose to direct sunlight.
- · Do not store above 35°C, below 5°C, or in humid areas. (Keep away from high/low temperatures or humidity.)

## Precautions on Use

## Product storage and management

- · If the charging cable falls in water, do not touch and disconnect the adapter immediately.
- · Careful attention should be paid to keep the product away from children's reach.
- · Do not place the cable near a heated surface.
- · In case of long-term storage, charge the product at least every 3 months to maintain battery life.
- · Do not poke between the gap with a key, hairpin, hanger, nail or other sharp metal.
- · Keep in the pouch (bag). When taking the product to another place, repack in the pouch (bag) that came with the product at the time of purchase.
- · Do not put near pesticide sprayers or other volatile liquids.
- $\cdot$  Do not wipe the surface too hard, as it may cause damage to the product.
- · Do not place near plastic or rubber for long hours under light.
- · Do not use alcohol, benzene, thinner or other strong chemicals, as they may ruin the surface of the product.
- $\cdot$  Do not put in the dishwasher, oven, or washing machine.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

- What modes can be used and what are the effects of each mode?
- Power mode and soft mode have the effect of taking a half bath with the use of far infrared and LED. The temperature setting is different for each mode, so the user can choose the right temperature. Beauty mode helps improve pigmentation in the Y ZONE with the use of far infrared and LED.
- How are far and near infrared different in terms of effectiveness?
- A Far infrared is absorbed by the water molecules in the body and delivers thermal energy from outside to deep inside the skin, and can penetrate through clothes. Near infrared penetrates into the dermal layers and help to activate the cells by stimulating biochemical reactions with light energy.
- How should the product be cleaned and how often?
- Wipe with the cleaning towel after each use. For more details, refer to the instructions in the user guide.

- Q Should I use the product on bare skin?
- A Far infrared is delivered to the body tissues through clothes. However, clothing causes LED light to scatter, and may reduce the effect. Therefore, using on bare skin is recommended for maximum effect, but using over thin clothes is also fine.
- How does the WHEROES thermal system work?
- Unlike other heating products, WHEROES adopts a heating plate that emits far infrared rays and transfers the radiant heat into the body while the temperature increases gradually.
- Is there any chance of getting low-temperature burns from far infrared rays?
- A Low-temperature burns occur at a temperature that would not cause burns within a short time period, but causes damage to the skin tissue as heat accumulates with temperature increase over time. It is known to occur after 6 hours at 44°C, and 3 hours at 45°C. WHEROES lets the temperature increase slowly with far infrared at power mode, and there is no risk of low-temperature burns.

#### Features

Dual Power System capable of transmitting of Red Light, Near Infrared Ray and Far Infrared Ray simultaneously,

Far infrared emitted from nano-silver carbon heater penetrates deep into the skin, and red light and near infrared LED help to activate the cells.

### 3 special care modes for health and beauty

Power mode and soft mode help strengthen the Y ZONE area, and beauty mode makes it healthy and beautiful.

# Instructions

## How to Use



- \* When the time ends for the selected mode, operation ends automatically with a voice
- \* Press and hold the power button 😈 for one second to stop using.
- \* Be careful when using the Y pad if you are allergic to metal.

# Instructions

## Mode

M You can change the mode with the number of clicks on the mode button.

M Number of clicks	Mode	Temperature	Time
1	Power Mode ←	Strong	20 min.
2	Soft Mode	Mild	20 min.
3	Beauty Mode	Mild	17 min.

- Select power mode or soft mode if you want the effect of taking a half bath.
- Select beauty mode if you want to improve skin tone in the groin area.
- The thermal sensation for each mode is felt gradually, and may change depending on the ambient temperature, body temperature or clothing material.
- \* Up to 2 consecutive times of use is recommended per person. After 2 times, take a rest for well over an hour.

# **Haptic function**

- Press and hold the mode button M for 2 seconds to use haptics.
- \* Haptic function gives slight vibrations at regular intervals, and only works in the main body.

# Silent/Voice mode setting

- Press and hold the power button of for 2 seconds to change to silent mode.
- To remove from silent mode, hold the power button again for 2 seconds.


# **Cleaning After Use**

# Main Body



Wipe the light-emitting part of the main body with the cleaning towel after use

# Y Pad



Wipe the light-emitting part of the Y pad with the cleaning towel after use.

- \* Cleaning with water is not recommended, as the product is not waterproof.
- \* If there is a severely contaminated area, wipe only the contaminated area with a wet tissue, then immediately wipe the remaining moisture with a clean towel.
- \* If the cleaner towel is contaminated, hand-wash the towel with lukewarm water (40 °C or less) with a neutral detergent and dry it in a well-ventilated shade.






Wired charging

while device is in use)




Wireless charging Connect the Y pad to the main body terminal. (Cannot be charged while Y pad is in use)

- \* When you hear "Please use after charging", charge before using again.



\* Usage time may be reduced in case of using the charger port to charge another device while the product is operating.

# **Battery**

- The battery is built into the device.
- It takes approximately 10 hours 30 minutes to fully charge a depleted battery for the main body and Y pad, and 6 hours 30 minutes to fully charge the Y pad only.
- After fully charging, the main body and Y pad can each be used 3 consecutive times at power mode. Up to 2 consecutive times of use is recommended per person.
- \* Charging times may vary for different adapter specifications.

#### Caution Caution

- Do not look into LED light from a close distance.
- If you have skin problems or are taking long-term medication, please inquire the place you purchase before use.

Product does not function properly.	Check if the power button is on.     Charge the device according to user instructions.     Check if the LED indicator light is on when charging the device.
Product does not turn on.	Battery is discharged.     Charge the battery.     Connect the charger to the power supply unit.     Check if the voltage requirement is in compliance with the local supply voltage.     Connect the main body and Y pad to the charger and check if they work.
LED indicator light does not turn on when charging.	· If the battery is left discharged for a long time, the LED indicator light might not turn on. Fully charge and check again.
LED light is dim.	· If LED light is dim, fully charge and check again.
Temperature does not go up.	· Check if the power button is on. · Charge the battery.

# **Troubleshooting**

## Warranty

Repair warranty period: 12 months

Ouality warranty period: 12 months / Battery warranty period: 6 months

- \* The warranty card enclosed with your purchase must be presented at the time of request for repair.
