
position and stitch the outlines of the frames, as the spacing is exactly the same for both versions and it

I promise you this will make checking all frames are correctly positioned significantly easier (trust me, I did it, and those additional bits can make it confusing!) Number one top tip, check your counting and then check it again! Key 2

If stitching the 'Shining Wallpaper' version I strongly recommend using the 'Fancy Black' border chart to

super clear, hence this key!




'Shining Wallpaper' layout too. I used grey for the shadows behind the frames (DMC 413), but any grey



Shining Wallpaper


