## Sewing Machine Cover Planner

Using a soft tape measure, write down the following measurements:

1. Length of the machine (left to right)

Inches. Then divide this number by 5 . Write that number here:

2. Up and over the machine (place the tape at the bottom of front, pull it over the highest point of the machine and then down to the bottom of the machine in back).
$\qquad$ Inches. Then divide this number by 5 . Write that number here:


Using the numbers in the square spaces above, multipy them to determine how many 5 " squares you will need to cut.

For example, if your numbers are 5 and 7 , then you will need 355 " squares. The quilt grid will look like this: 5 Squares across, 7 rows.

Note: If you need 42 or fewer squares, your cover is charm pack friendly.
