Supply List for Free Motion Ruler Work class

- Sewing Machine in good working order. You must be able to lower the feed dogs on the machine.
- Extension tray/table for your machine (or an acrylic Sew Steady table)
- the ruler foot for your sewing machine (#72 foot for Berninas)
- Rulers a ruler with a straight-edge; a circle ruler in a frame $(3'' 4 \frac{1}{2}'')$ diameter preferred but bring whatever you have); a wavy ruler ***
- Optional: clamshell ruler
- Quilting gloves
- 1½ yards of muslin, cut into 6 pieces 18" x half the WOF (42-44")
- 3 pieces of batting, 18" x 22"
- Small Rotary ruler (at least 12")
- Fabric Marking pen/pencil
- Paper and pencil
- Thread & bobbin use a medium to dark color so you can see your designs
- Handi Grip strips by HandiQuilter
- Optional, but strongly suggested: Supreme Slider or Sew Slip II
- Basic sewing supplies scissors, pins, ripper, etc
- Pillow(s) to sit on

***Rulers

NOTE: the rulers must be for machine quilting, NOT rotary cutting rulers!

If you own straight-edge, circle or wavy machine quilting rulers, bring them to class.

If you own the Bernina ruler set, that's all you need for class.

If you don't own the required rulers or the Bernina Ruler set, here are some suggested rulers :

Straight-edge: Angela Walters Slim; Judi Madsen's A1 Ruler 9" Longarm Straight Ruler, Amanda Murphy Good Measure Every Curve Set of 3

Circle Ruler: Westalee Simple Circles Set 2, set of 4 Templates (2.5" – 4")

Wavy Ruler: <u>Amanda Murphy Good Measure Every Wave Set of 3; Angela Walters Elvira; Angela Walters Squiggy</u>

If you have other machine quilting rulers, bring them to class. If there's time, we will review them.

I will be bringing some straight edge, circle and wavy rulers to class for you to use, if necessary.

Before Class:

- 1. If your rulers are new, remove the paper from the backs of the rulers.
- 2. Make 3 quilt 'sandwiches', layering 1 piece of batting between 2 pieces of muslin.
