HARALSON BELT BAG - Supplies and Class Preparation

SUPPLIES:

The shop kit contains everything you need.

If you are not purchasing the kit, you need the following: <u>Haralson Belt Bag pattern</u>

Fabric Requirements - Please read the pattern too:
Exterior Fabric -midweight canvas or cotton twill:
If you are using one fabric, like the shop sample: 1/3 yard
If you are using an accent fabric on the flap: One fat quarter for the exterior AND
One fat quarter for the accent flap
Lining Fabric - quilting cotton: ½ yard or 1/3 yard directional fabric
Fusible Woven Interfacing – 1 ¾ yards, I used 20" wide Pellon SF101, as suggested.

Zippers –pattern assumes zipper tape width of 1" to 1 ¼". EITHER one 8" zipper for back pocket, <u>and</u> one 6" zipper for interior pocket, OR ½ yard continuous zipper with two zipper pulls

Hardware –

(2) 1" wide D rings;

- (1) 1" wide strap slider; and
- (1) 1" wide swivel snaps for strap hardware.

The above three items are all contained in this hardware kit

In class we are installing the turn lock closure option -

(1) <u>Turn lock</u>

BEFORE CLASS:

Cut fabric and interfacing as instructed on page 3-5 of the pattern. Use the labels, and note that some pieces do get two layers of interfacing. Fuse all pieces and layers as instructed, and bring all labeled pieces to class.

Webbing – cut two 2 1/2 " pieces.

Do NOT cut the webbing further yet, as you may want leave your strap longer.

BRING TO CLASS:

Sewing machine with new microtex needle Size 14 or 16 denim Thread and full bobbins for piecing and topstitching Regular/piecing foot. I used my 1/4 " foot Zipper foot Chalk pen or water soluble pen <u>Glue pen</u> (this is not an error) Small cutting mat for next to your machine is helpful Ruler Rotary cutter with a sharp blade Wonder clips and pins Seam ripper (just in case [©])
