

Intermediate Kids Camp Supply List 2024

In this class you will do some cutting yourselves using templates / rulers and your fabric scissors! Be sure your scissors are sharp and good for fabric. ☺ Please separate project fabric into separate marked baggies or bundles so they don't get mixed up!

Fabric and supplies needed:

Interfacing:

- 1.5 yards - [SF 101](#) (Fusible Cotton "Shapeflex")
- 1/3 yard - [Fusible Fleece](#)

Crossbody Purse:

- 1 FQ for outside, 1 FQ for lining (or (2) 1/3 yard cuts also ok)
- ¼ yard for strap
- 14" polyester zipper
- (1) 1" slide buckle, (2) purse clasps with 1" opening, (2) D-rings any size 1" – ½"
(We have multi packs at PQW with these kinds of things all together for purses)

Patchwork Zipper pouch:

- This pouch uses (24) 3.5" squares. You can use scraps from home, or if you want to get new fabric, get 1/8 yard cuts or FQ's of 3 - 5 different fabrics. I will cut the squares for the kids before class (this is day 2 project) - but if you are using scraps / can cut at home you can do that and put them in a baggie all pre-cut too!
- 1/3 yard for lining
- 14" polyester zipper

Wedge skirt:

- 5 coordinating Fat Quarters. Buy 6 if hips circumference is over 42".
 - Highly directional fabric will generally end up sideways on the skirt as most fabric has the upright direction with the yardage. It looks fine as it is consistent, but I do encourage you not to use highly directional fabric if buying FQ's.
 - **For directional fabric buy (5 or 6) regular 1/3 yard cuts instead.**
- 1/6 yard for waistband (buy ¼ yard if hip circumference is over 41")
- 1 yard package of ¾" wide elastic.

These are all my patterns and provided as part of the class.

It is recommended to drop off the fabrics before the first day so I can cut Day 1 project fabrics ahead of time! (2 days before at least) If this is not possible I can still cut in class if needed, but the more people who drop off ahead of time, the better.

General supplies needed every day:

- Mettler cotton thread to match projects (4 smaller spools or 1-2 larger spools).
The skirt needs a lot of thread for seam finishing so 2 small spools for that alone.
- Sewing machine, power cord / foot pedal
- Zipper foot, all purpose foot, and 1/4" foot if available.
- Sewing box supplies.
- Ball head pins
- Dressmaker fabric scissors of at least 4" long
- Pencil
- [Disappearing ink purple fabric marker](#)
- [10 pack of wonder clips](#)
- [6x1" omnigrid ruler](#) or similar.
- Big safety pin
